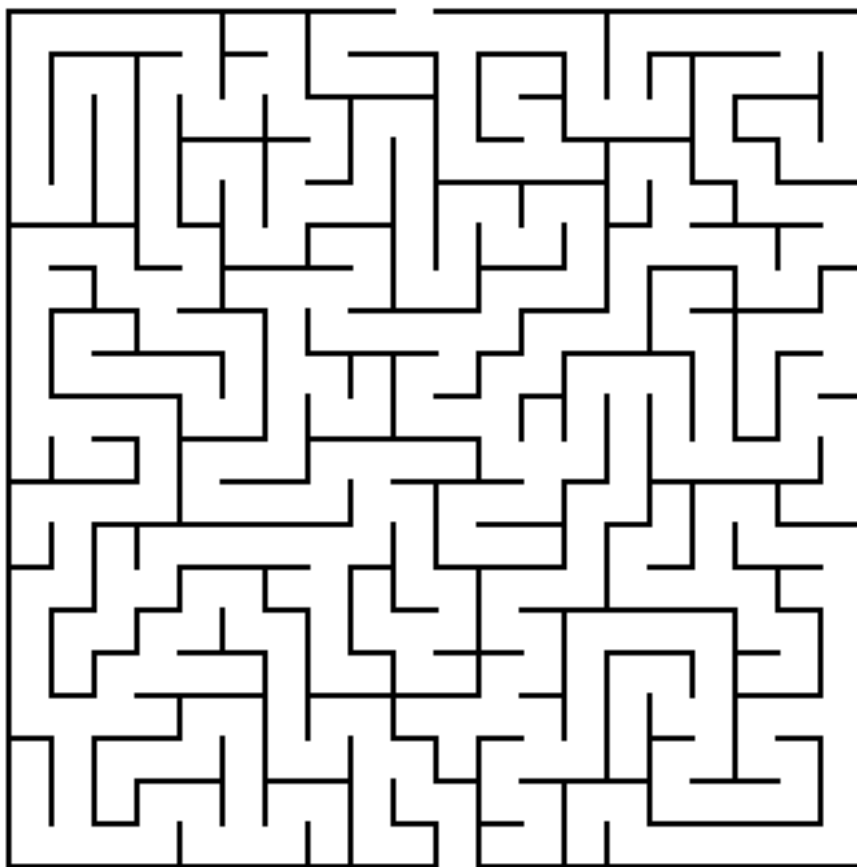

“I thought I’d better eat *him* first.”



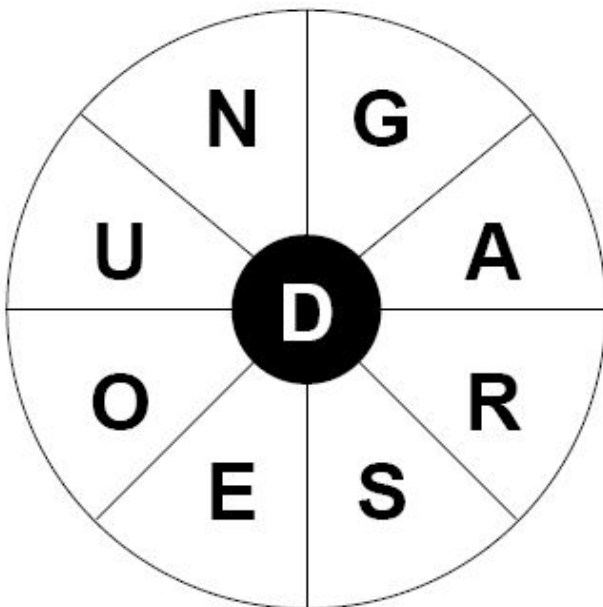
## Sock skills

How many words can you make with the letters from the word wheel? Each word must use the letter in the centre of the wheel.

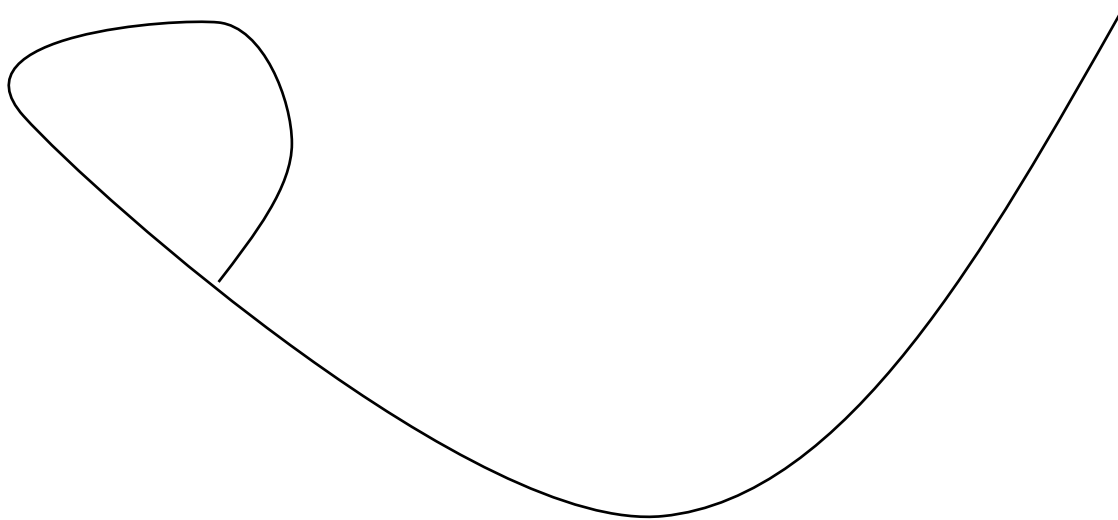
