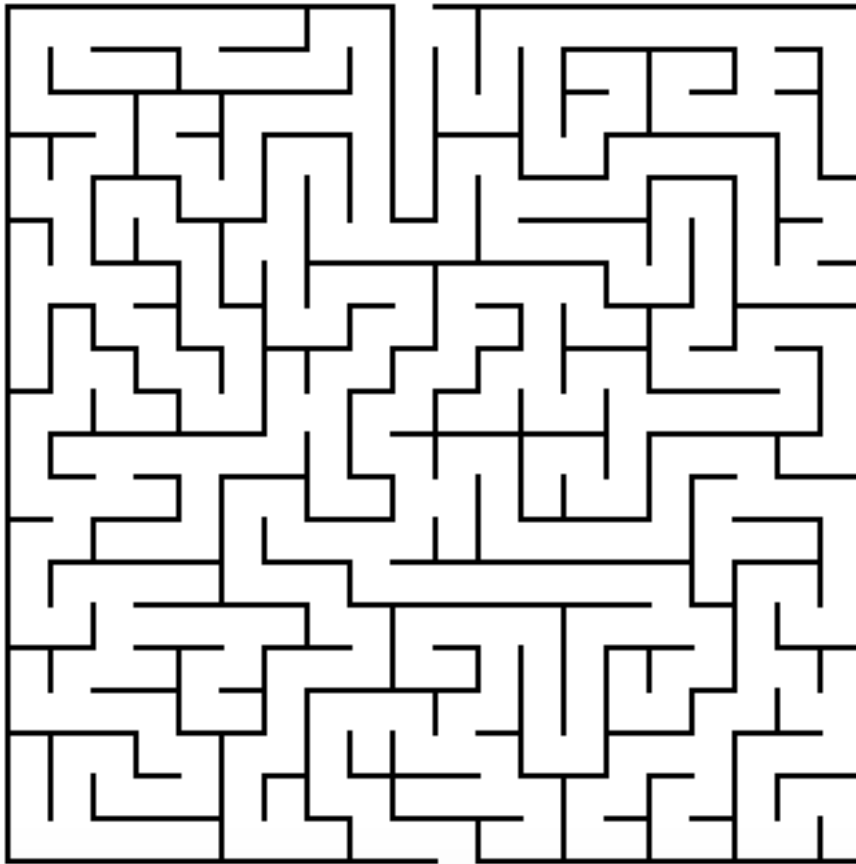

And that has made all the difference.

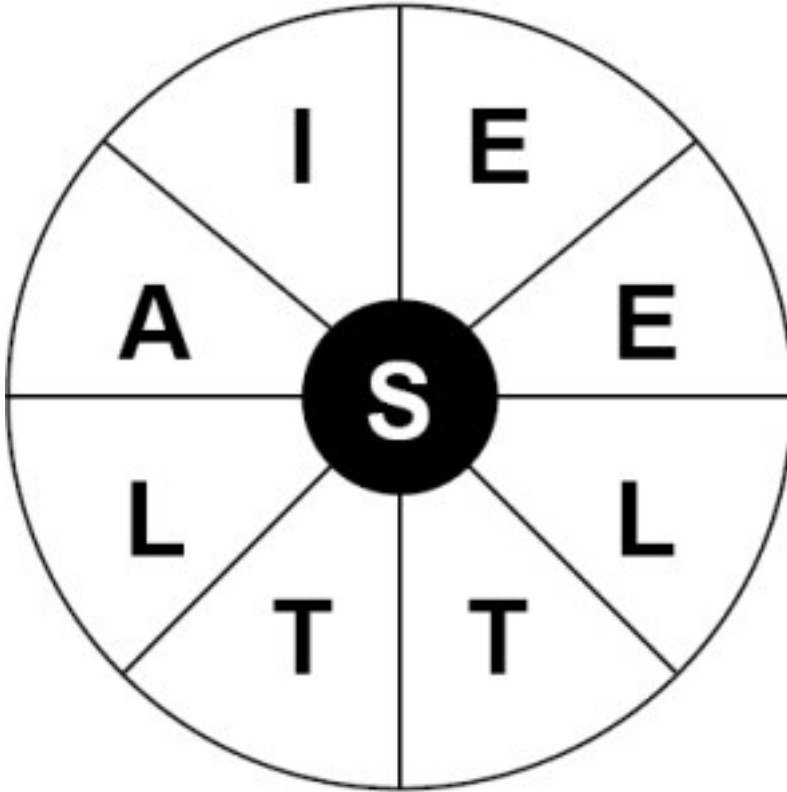
Make some coconut ice

You need:

- 250g sweetened condensed milk
 - 250g icing sugar
 - 200g desiccated coconut
 - Pink edible food colouring
1. Mix the condensed milk with the icing sugar, it will become very stiff- use your hands if you wish.
 2. Add the coconut until it's all combined
 3. Split the mixture, put the pink food colouring in one mixture and stir until thoroughly pink.
 4. Dust a lipped baking tray with icing sugar, spread the white mixture on the tray and flatten out.
 5. Add the pink mixture on top and spread it out to match the white mixture.
 6. Leave uncovered overnight
 7. Cut into squares and eat.

- brushes
- scissors
- pencil
- ruler

What to do:

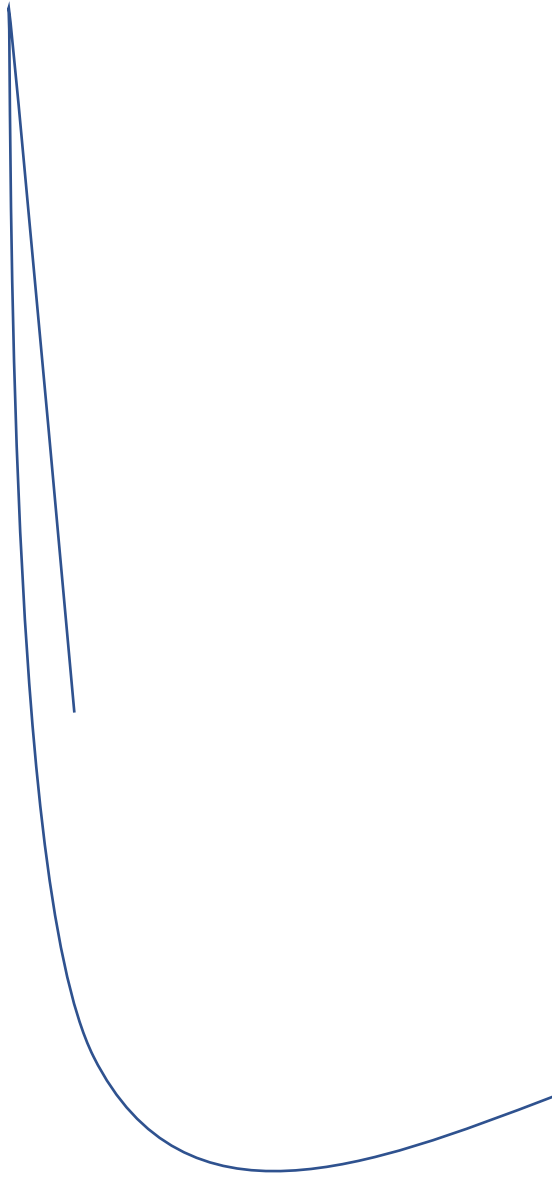
- Draw out a rectangle on your card with a ruler with pencil.
- Carefully cut out the rectangle.
- Then apply painter's tape in whatever pattern you choose and start painting! Be sure to press down on the edge of the tape firmly so you get clean lines.
- Once the paint is dry peel off the tape.
- Add the tape again in a different direction to paint another colour.
- Wait to dry and then use in your book or give to someone else as a gift.
