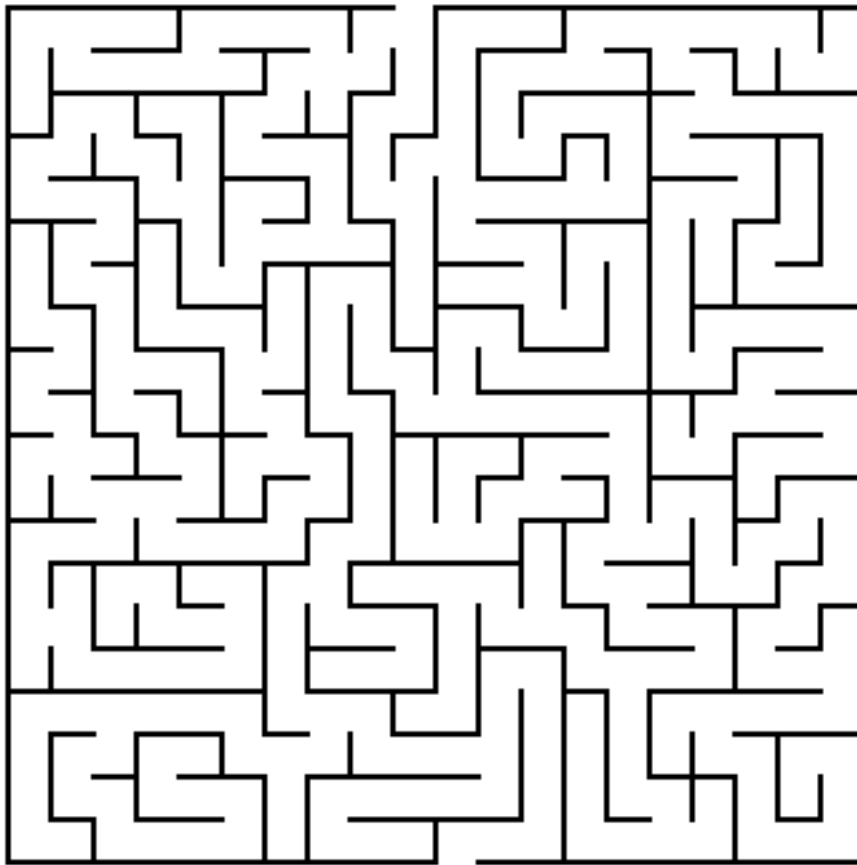

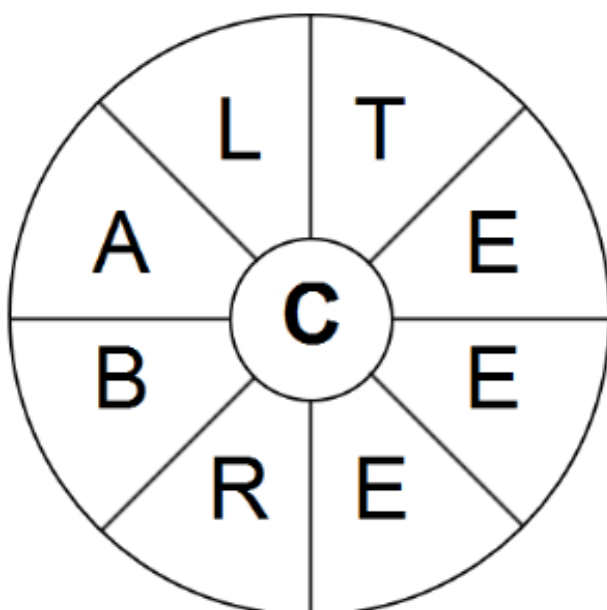

1. Start with a square piece of paper.



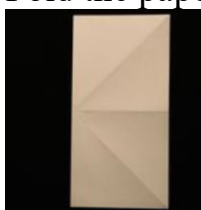
2. Fold the paper in half to make a triangle. Then unfold.

7. Turn the paper over then once again fold all the corners to the centre.



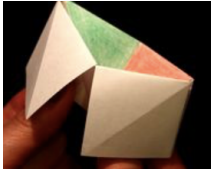
8. Colour all the triangles in different colours.



9. Write a fortune under each triangle and fold down again.

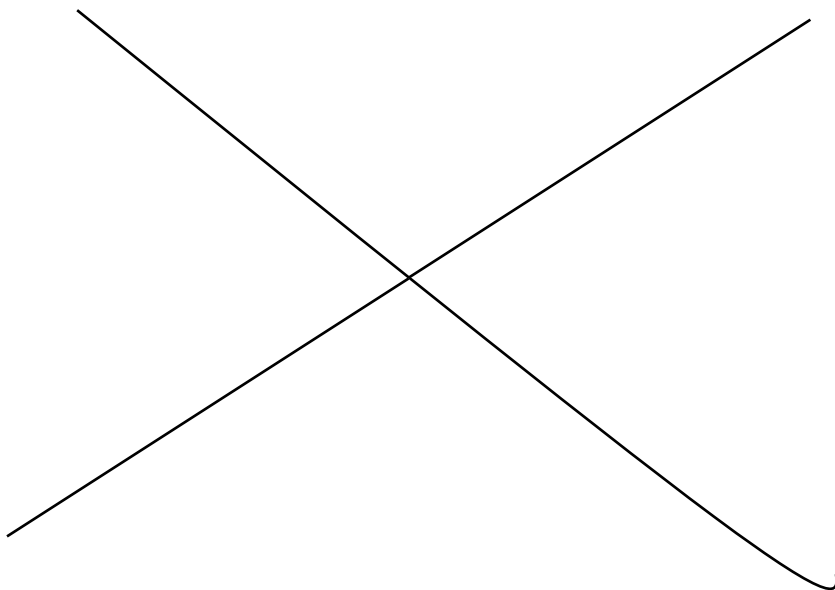


10. Fold the bottom half to the top.

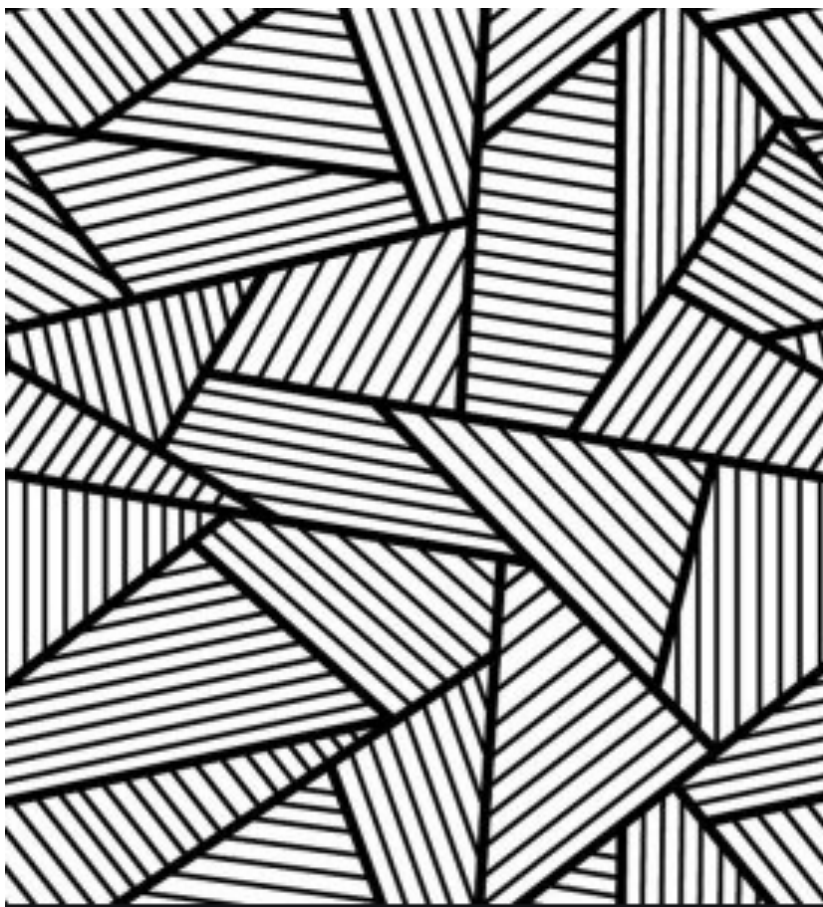


11. Tuck your thumbs and forefingers in the four openings below. Now you are ready to play.

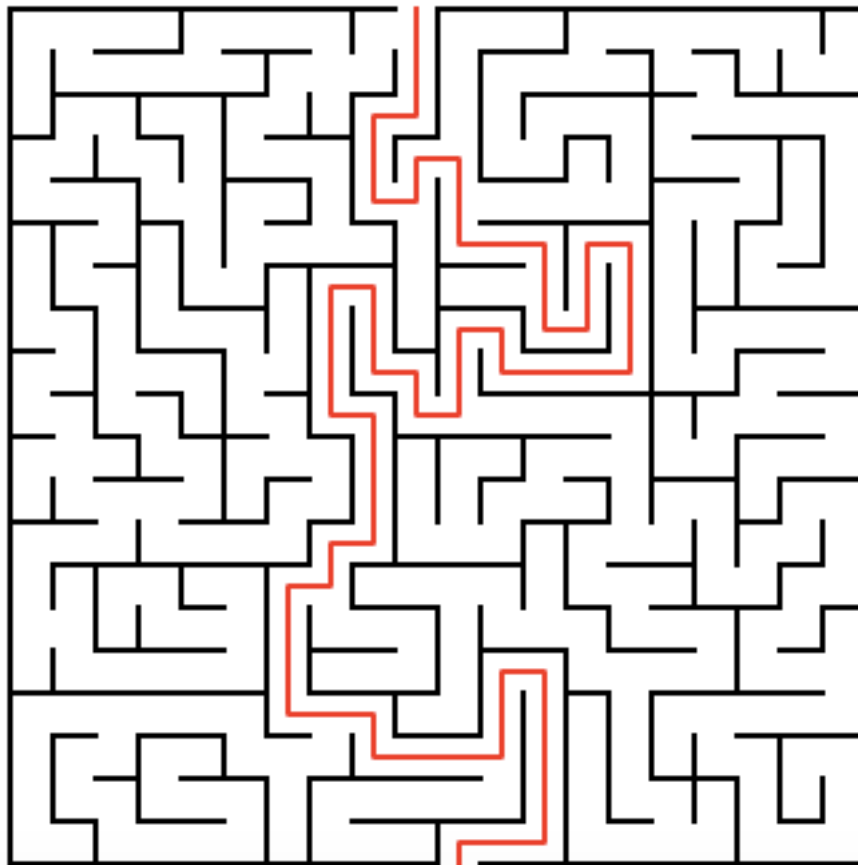
