Draw:

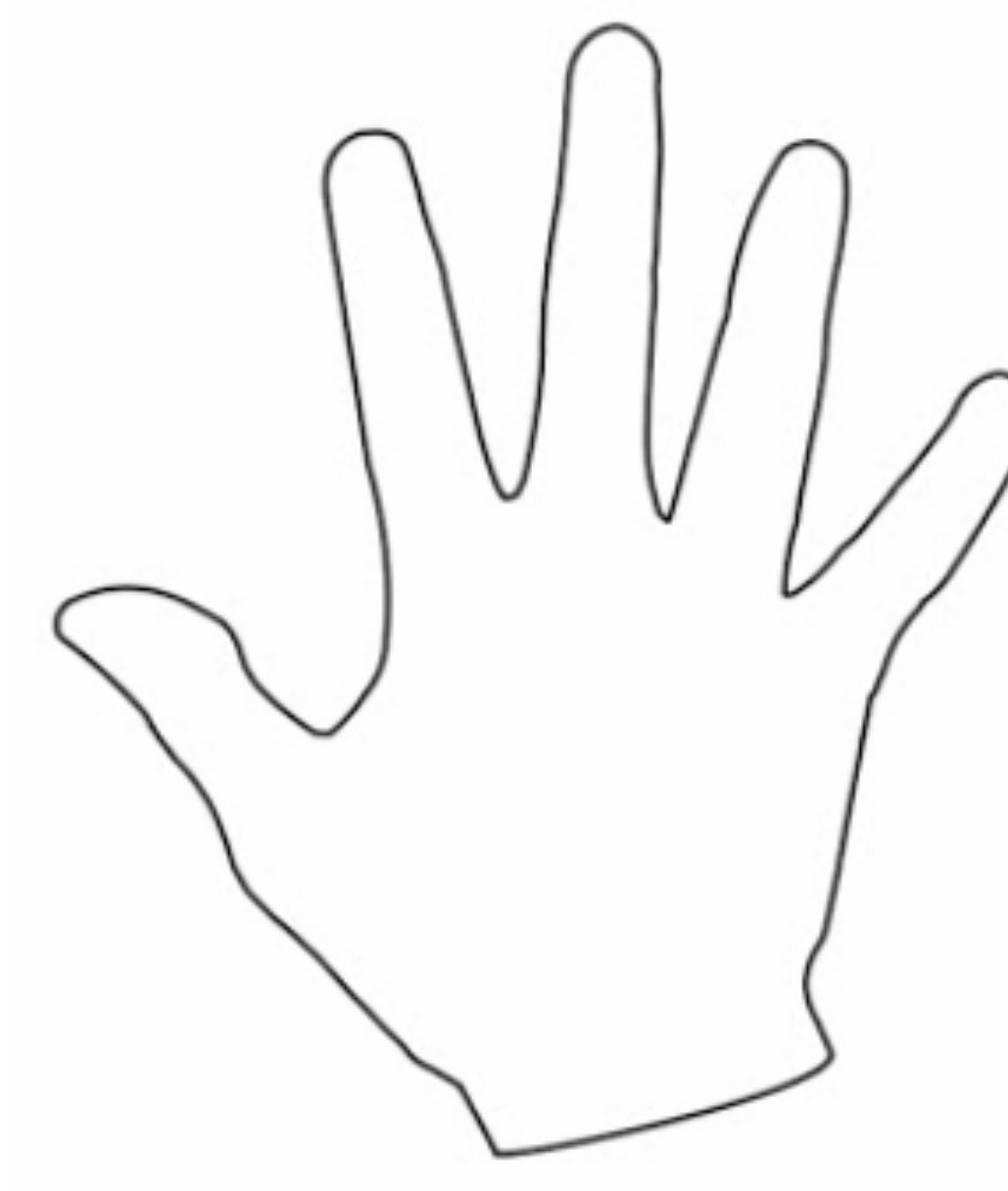
- Something strong

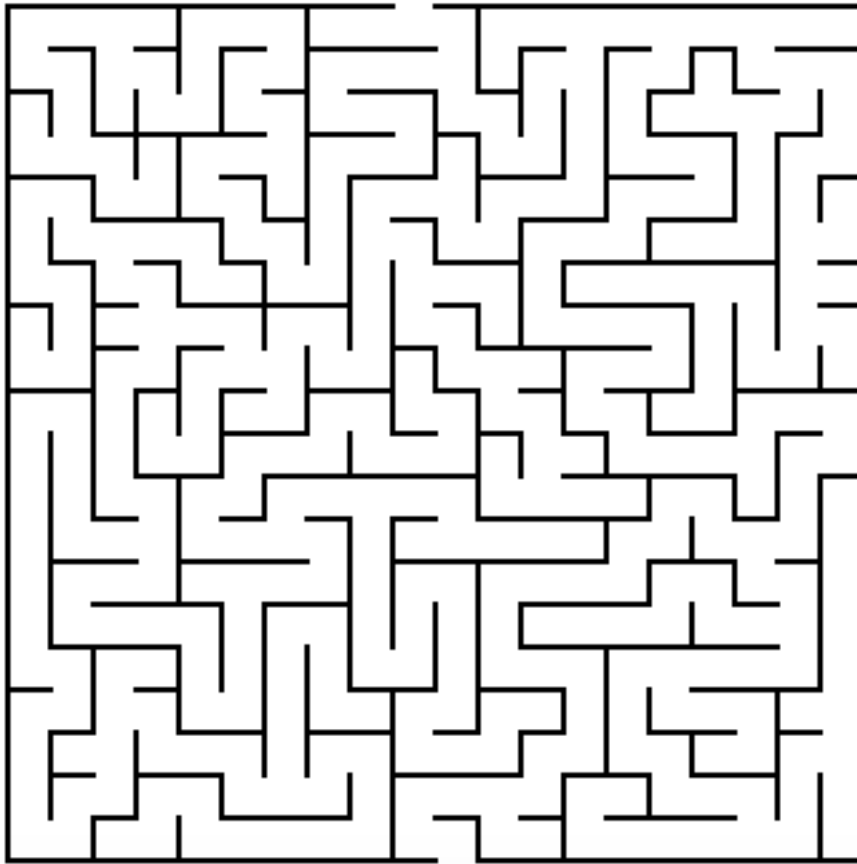

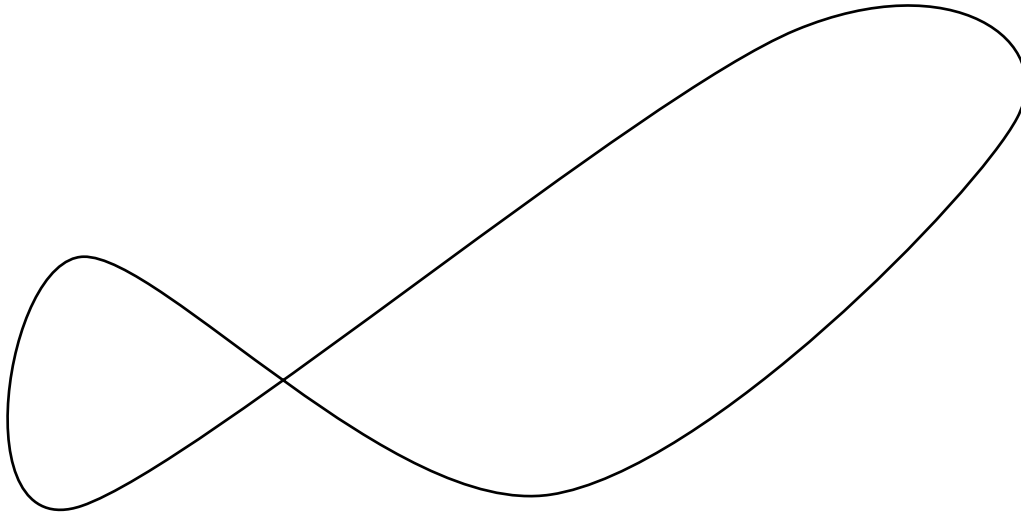

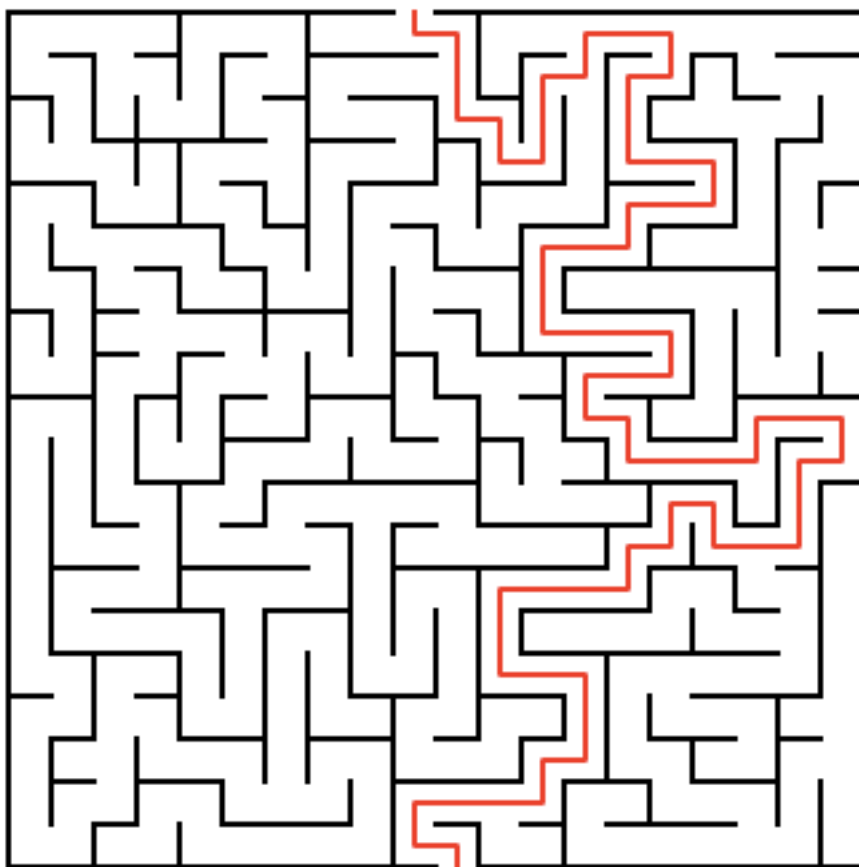
