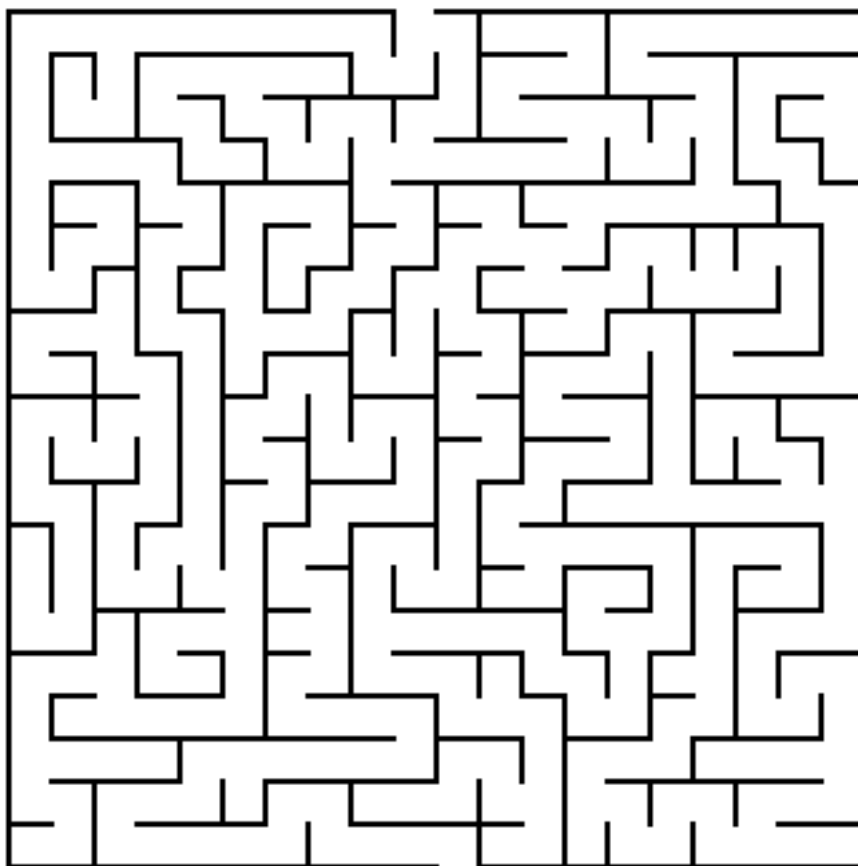

will I be like this? How will I manage?

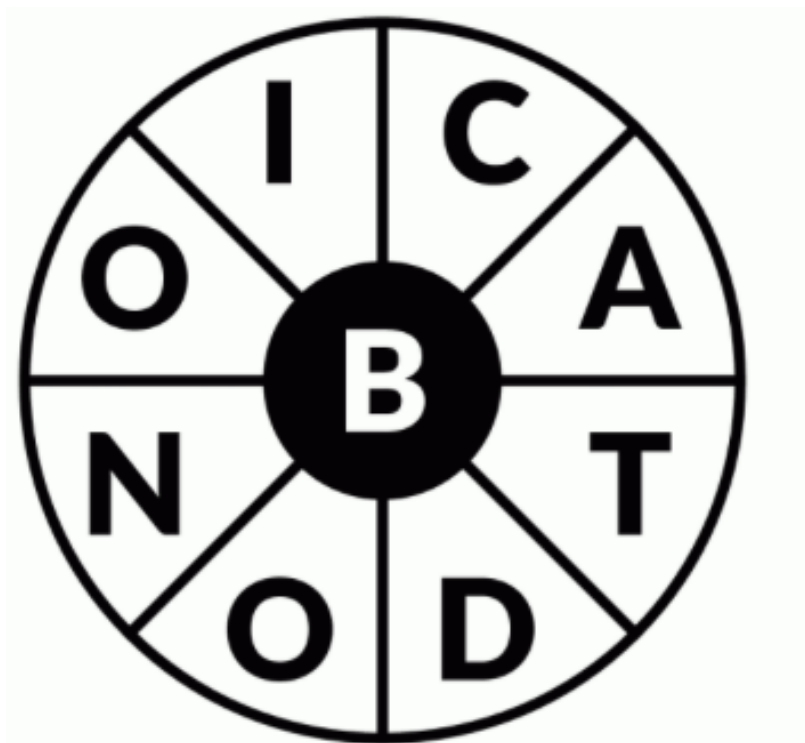
After that he chooses a log

A pair of scissors

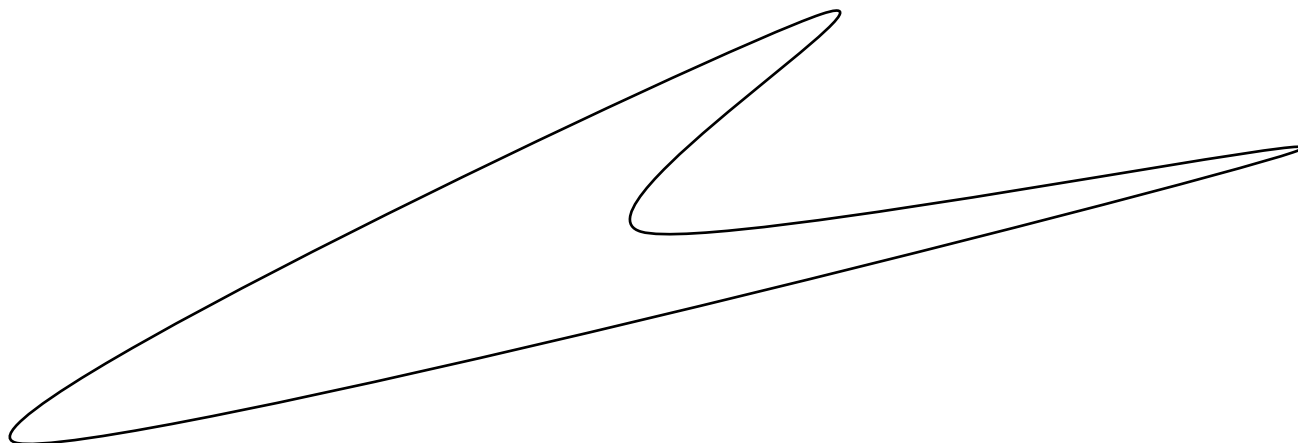
1. Cut the toilet roll middles in half, length ways.
