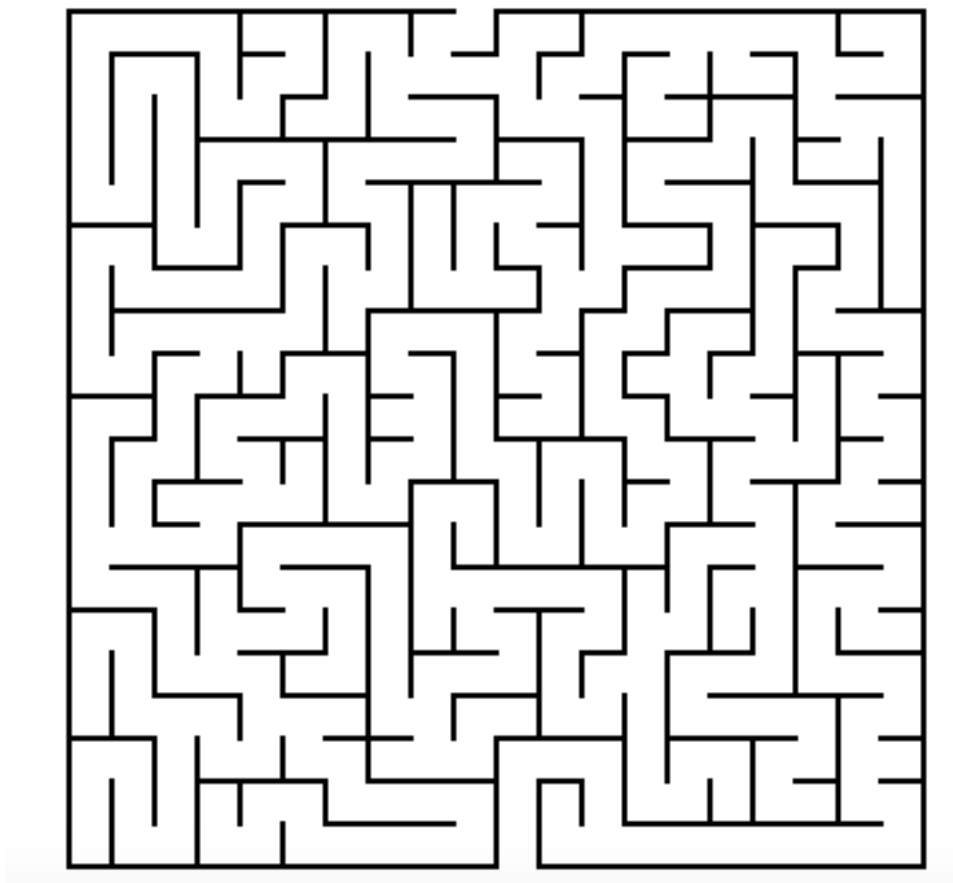

with a changing expression, in silence.

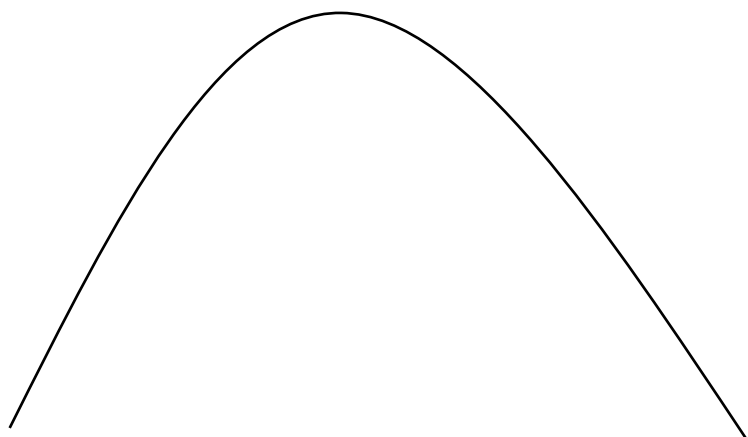
Stay, I said to my loves.

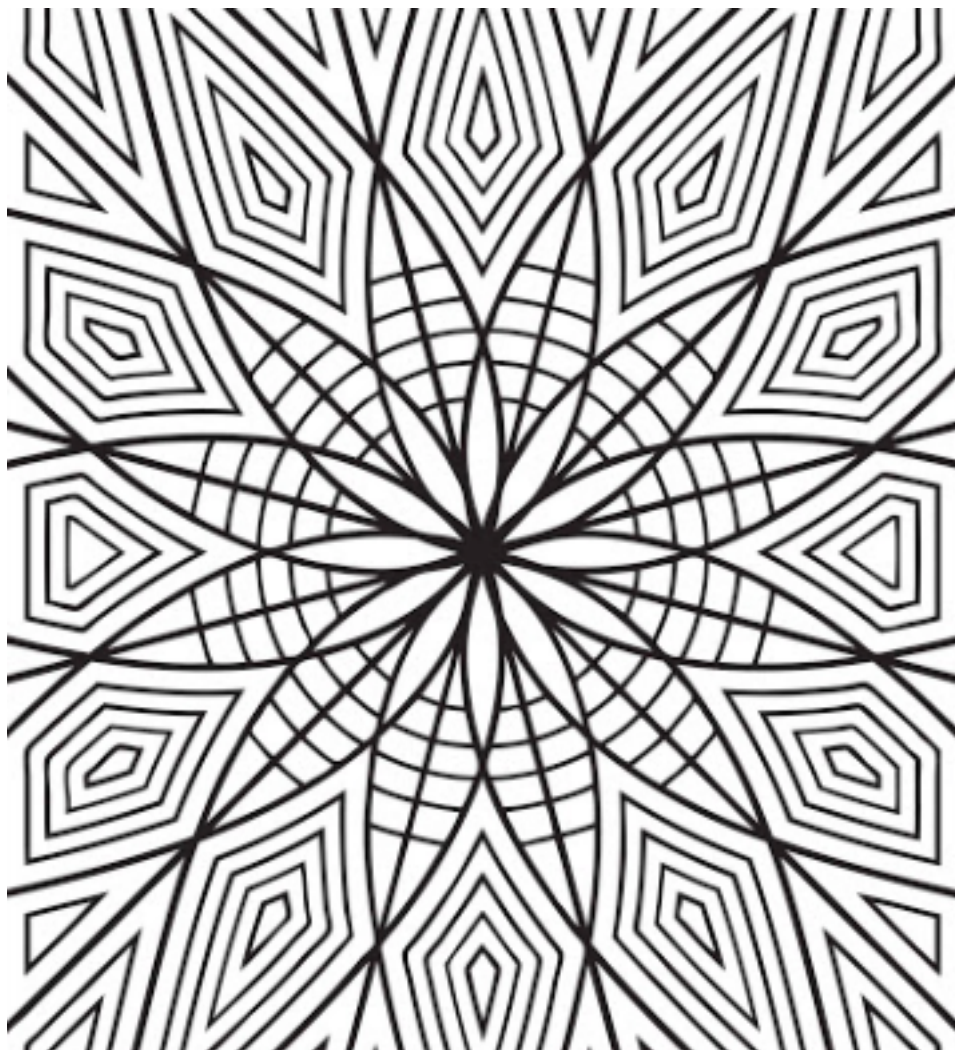

Pompom races

You will need:

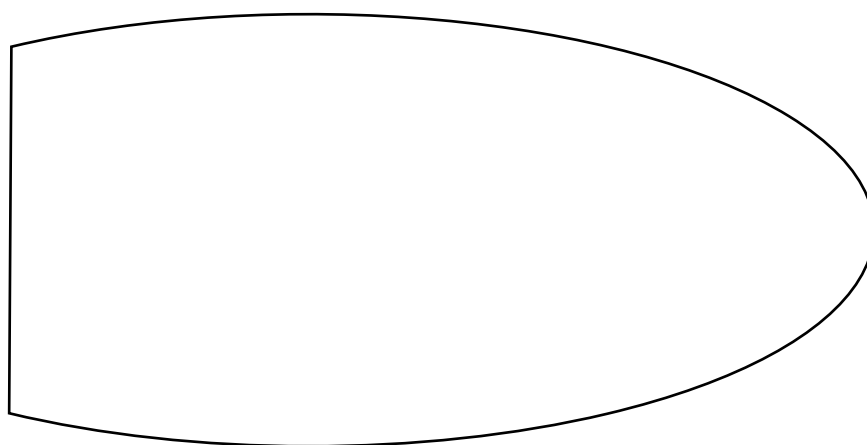
- A straw
 - Some masking tape
 - A small material pompom, or rolled up foil/ clingfilm will work
 - A flat surface such as a table
1. Mark out a track using the tape, make it as interesting as you can with bends etc
 2. Put the pompom on one end of the tape
 3. Using the straw blow the pompom on the track of the tape, following the course as closely as possible.
 4. See how fast you can get around the track
 5. See how closely you can match the track.

Make finger puppets

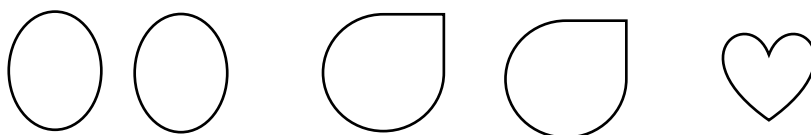
You will need:

- lollipop sticks
- 2 colours of felt
- googly eyes
- glue

1. Cut out of felt the shape below twice. This will be the body



2. Cut out ears, nose and eyes in a different colour to the one used for the body.



3. First glue the ears on one body shape, then glue the body pieces together with the lolly stick in the centre of the two body pieces.
4. Glue on the eyes, nose and any other details you wish.

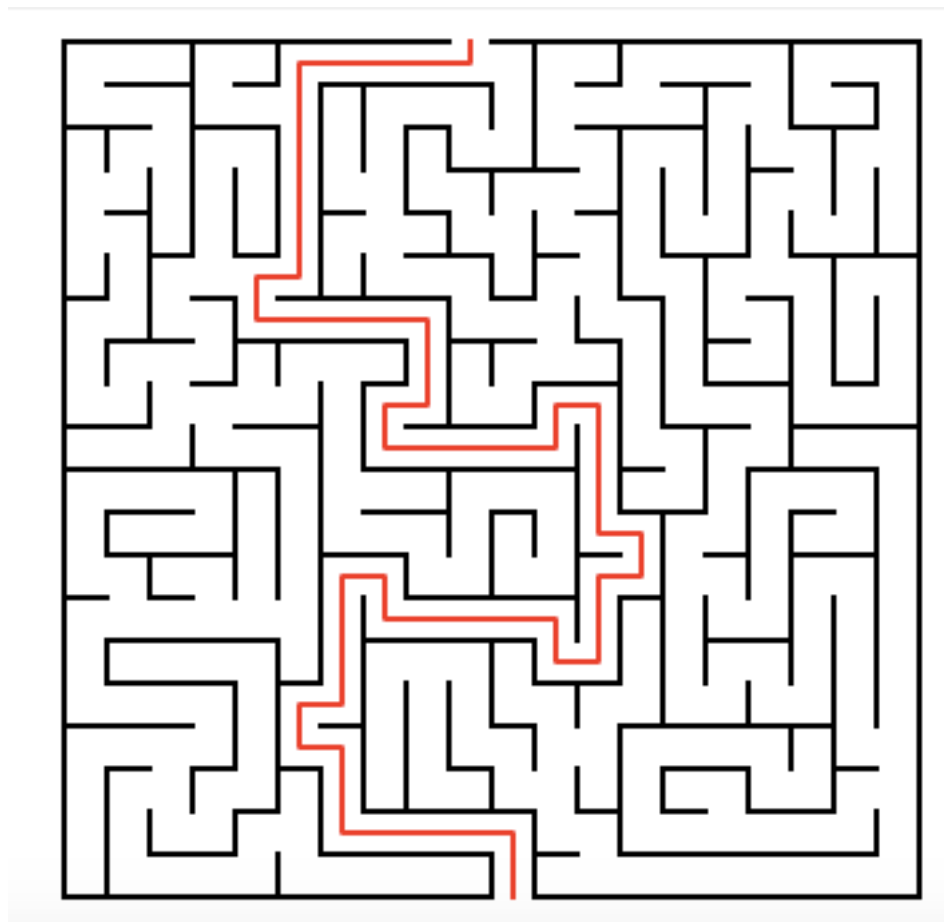
