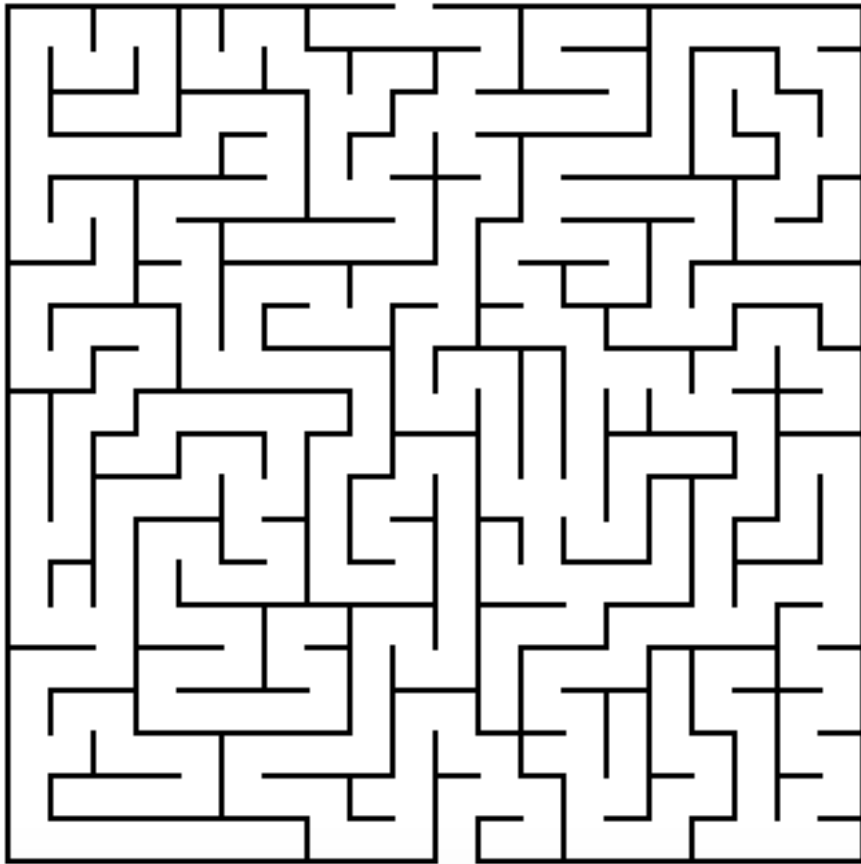

Even the loons call to celebrate their arrival!

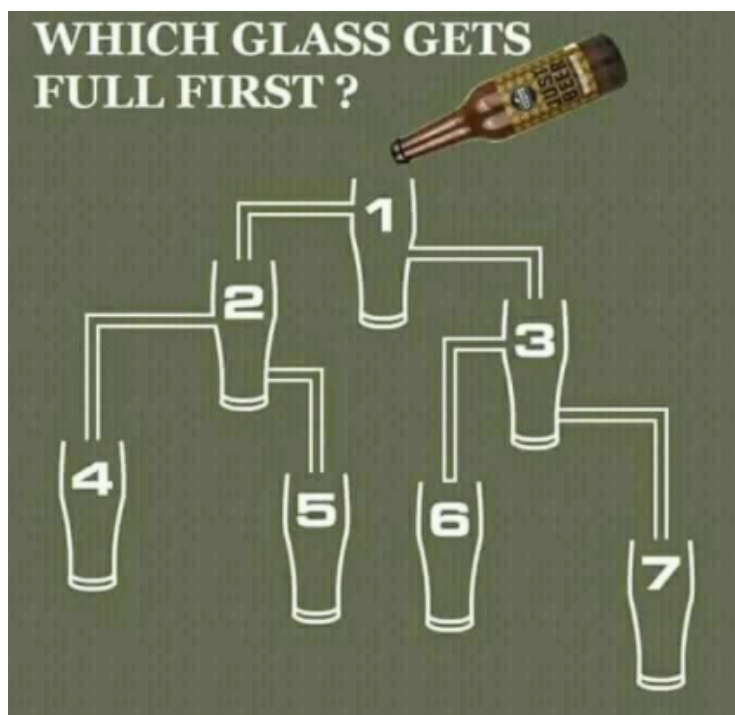
I sit on my dock

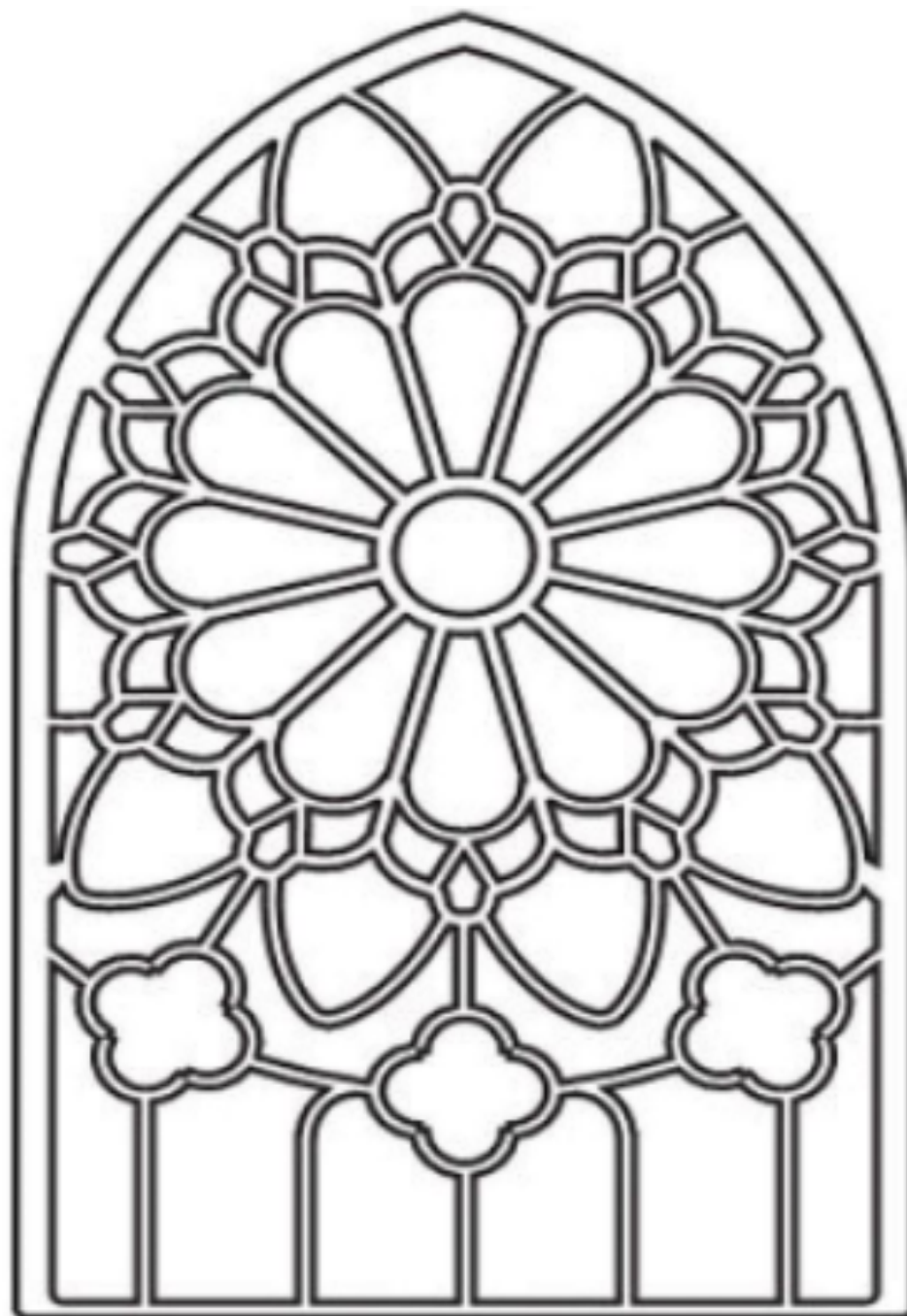

Make your own drum kit

You will need:

- Clean tubs, this can be an old pringles packet, a Tupperware box or something else.
- Balloons
- Rubber bands
- Two pieces of dowel
- Beads with holes the same size as the dowel
- Glue

What to do

- Cut the bottom off a balloon and stretch it tight over the open top of the container.
- Secure the balloon with a rubber band, and your drum is ready to play!
- Glue the dowels into the beads at one side, your drumsticks are ready to use!
- Make a variety of size and shapes to create different sounds.

The Freddie

Lift your right arm and leg Lift your left arm and leg. It sounds simple, but at high speeds, it can result in a crazy dance.

The Frug

Stand with your feet together and bend your knees slightly. Move your hips to the right, and then move them to the left. The movement should come from the hips rather than your knees. The frug is danced at a fast pace, and a right-left pair of hip movements should take a single count.

The Hitch-Hike

While doing the hip motions of the frug, hold your right hand in a fist with thumb extended, as if you are hitch-hiking. Move your thumb to the right for three counts. Clap your hands to the right on the fourth count. Switch hands and move your thumb to the left for three counts. Clap your hands, this time to the left, on the fourth count.

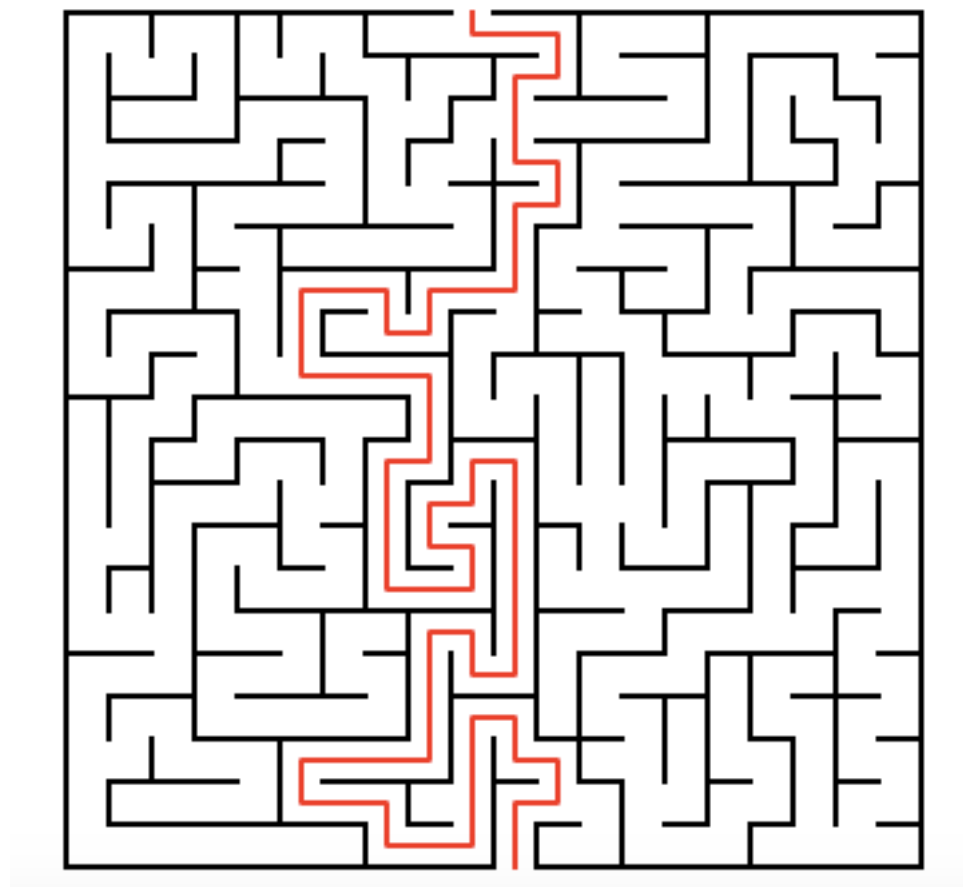
