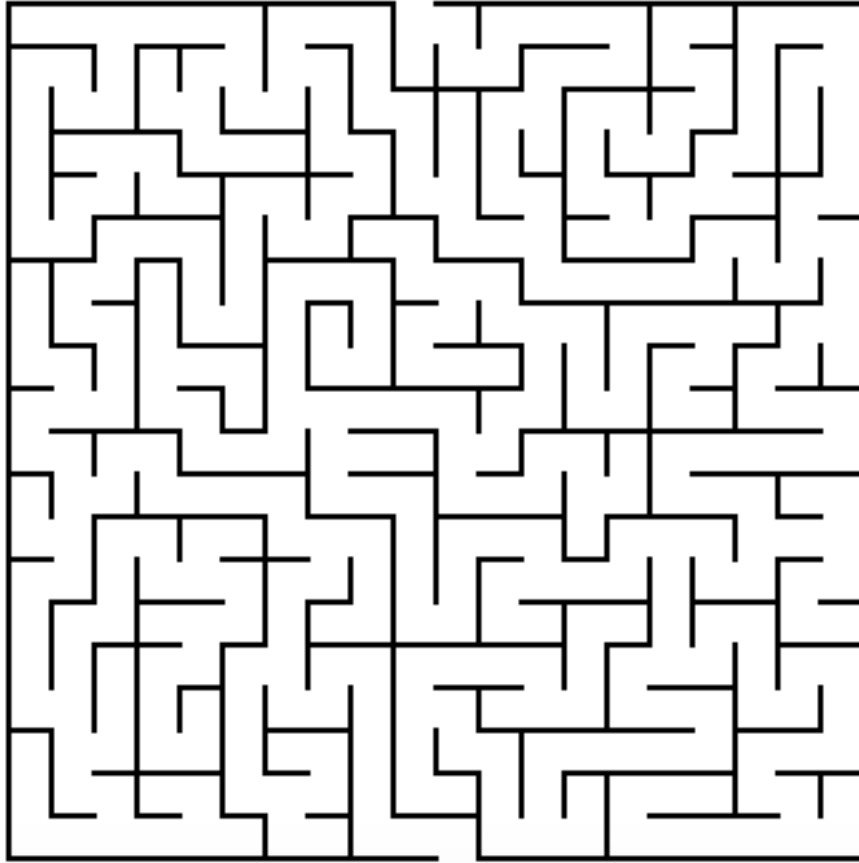

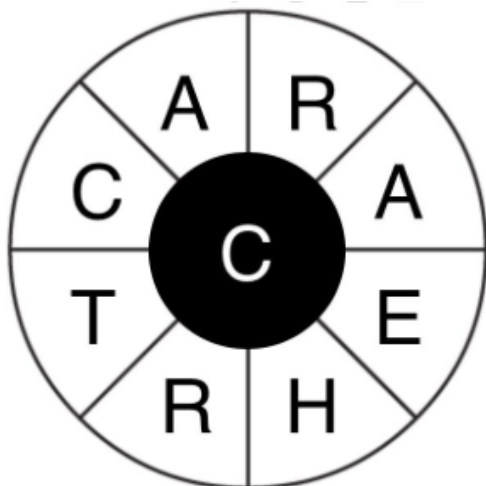

To travel this immensity.

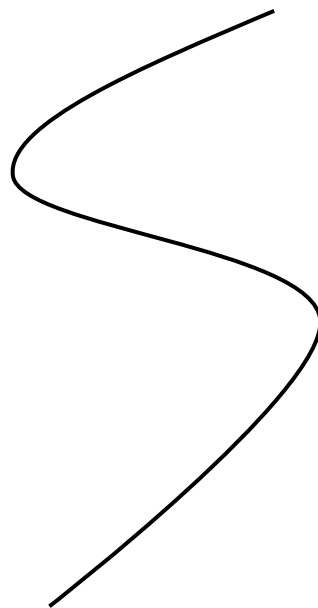
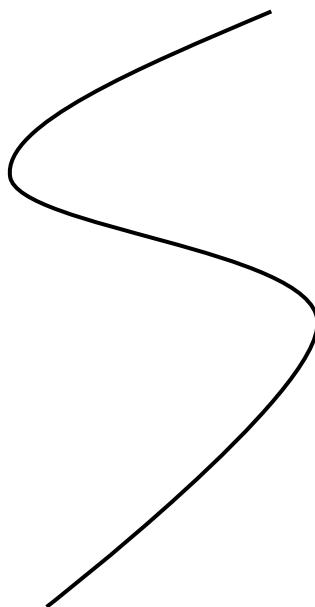
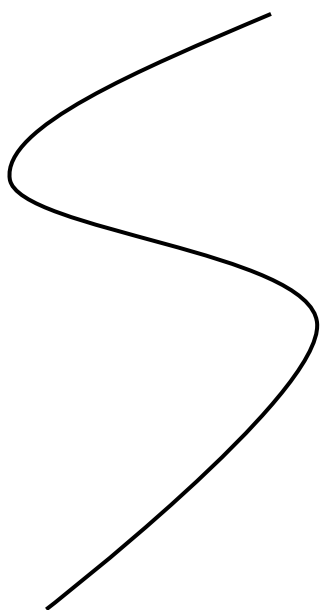
I battered the cordons around me

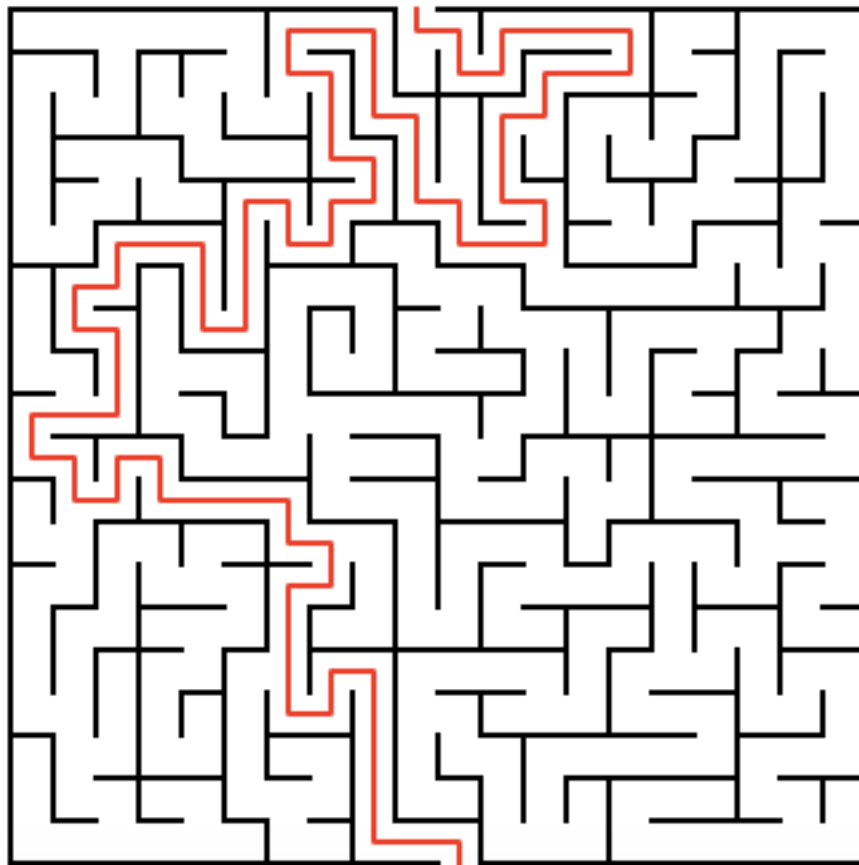
