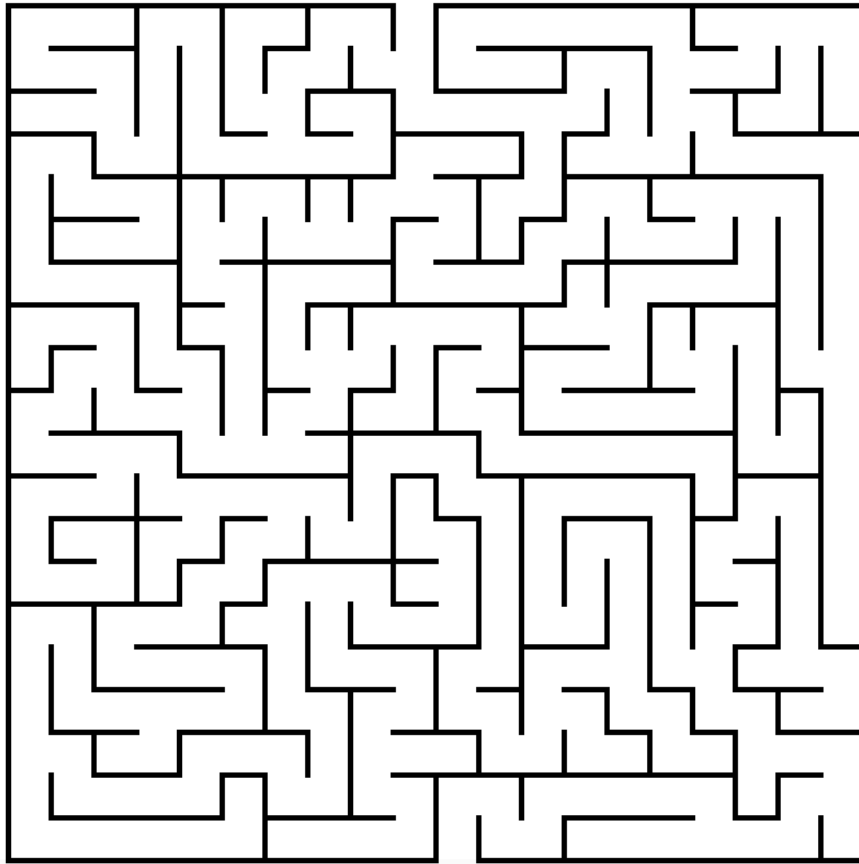

Read: My Voice by Rafael Campo

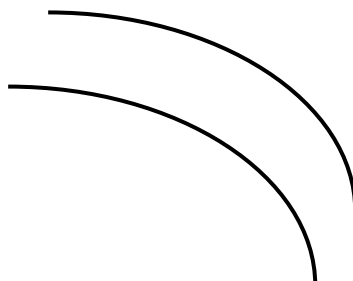
To cure myself of wanting Cuban songs,

2. Add the ends of the string within the container with the loop being outside.
3. Fill with water
4. Place in the freezer
5. Allow to freeze
6. Take out of the freezer and release from the container
7. Find a tree or place to hang the decorations.

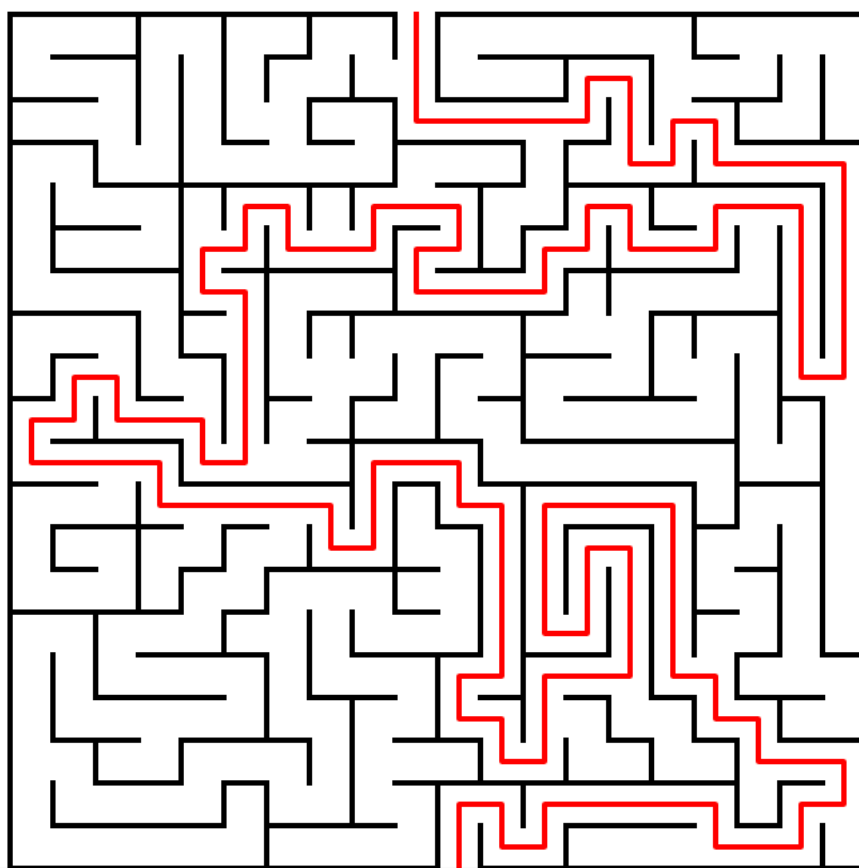
