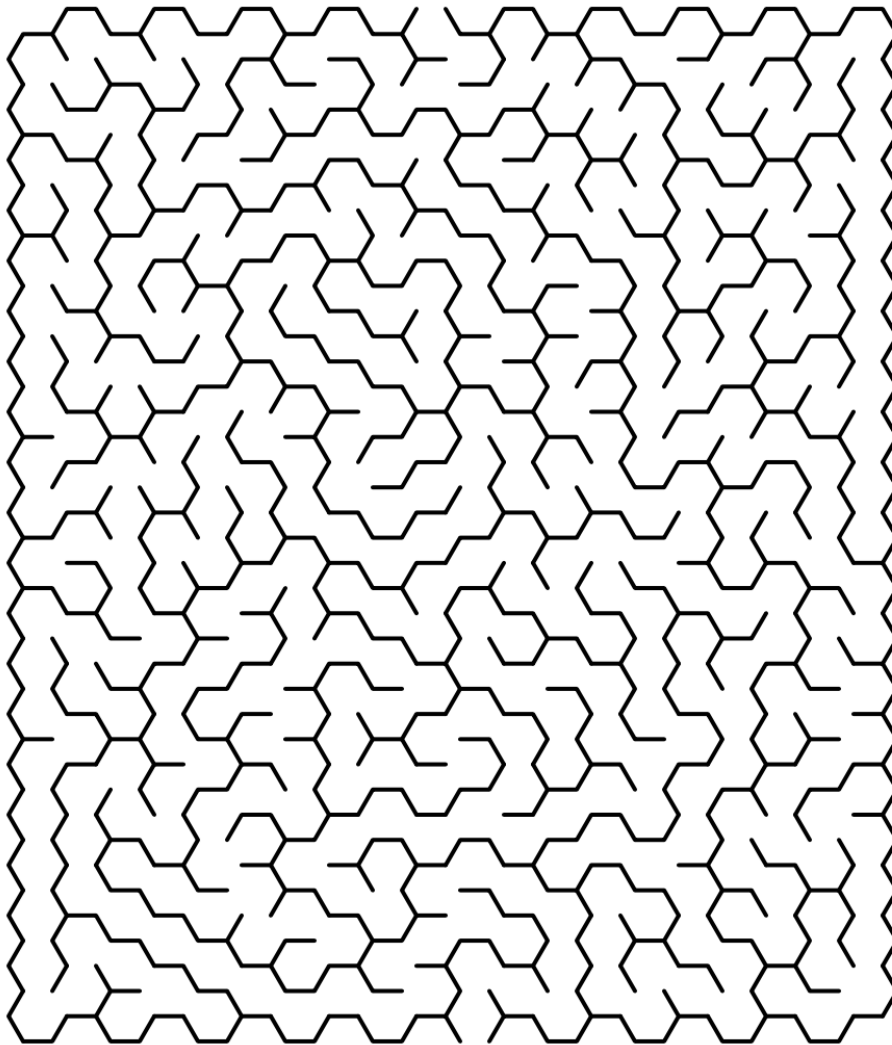

each bounce-back brings a stranger. can't call us for traveling because

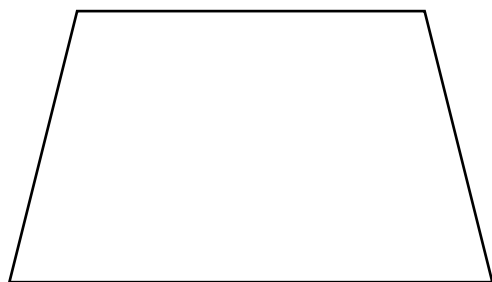
we ain't going nowhere. instead, we trade terrified looks. search
