**Many organisations are surveying staff regarding coming back to work, exploring the risks together and working to reduce them where possible. How can we reassure the public we are ready when looking to open up again?**

Why not survey people living with dementia and their carers about how they feel about accessing your space, exploring and trying to understand how they would feel regarding the risks of COVID-19 and accessing the space again.

You would be able to share the steps you have taken to reduce the risks and also highlight the risks that still remain to help people make an informed decision about returning.

This will also help you to understand when to open up as there is little point in you working hard to make a session available face to face if then people don't feel like they can return due to their own concerns.
