Visiting and befriending

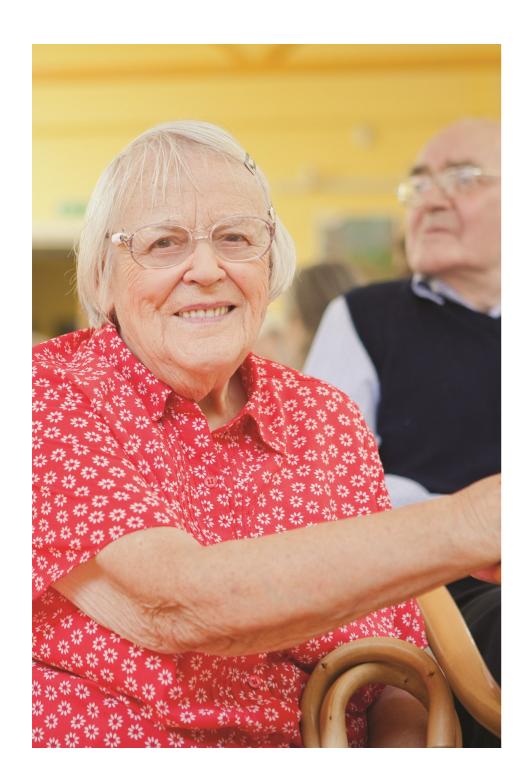
Age UK Shropshire Telford & Wrekin has a team of volunteers who provide friendship and support for older people.

Dementia support

Our experienced staff and volunteers provide a range of services designed to support people living with dementia and their carers.

Dementia respite

Our weekly dementia respite service provides time for carers to run errands, meet friends or simply have a few hours to themselves, safe in the knowledge that their loved one is being cared for.

Run by qualified carers supported by experienced volunteers and our Dementia Support Workers, the service provides high quality activities tailored to individual needs.

Dementia support groups

Our dementia support groups welcome local people with dementia and memory difficulties, their families, carers and friends.

The groups provide a chance to get to know others and share experiences in a friendly and relaxed atmosphere.

They provide members with support and information and an opportunity to take part in interesting activities, coordinated through our team of trained volunteers.

Help at Home

Our Help at Home scheme enables older people to remain independent at home for as long as possible. Our Home Support Workers provide practical assistance by carrying out everyday tasks that an older person might find difficult to manage.

What sort of work do we do?

- Vacuuming and dusting
- Bathroom and kitchen cleaning
- Shopping
- Collecting prescriptions
- · Laundry and ironing
- Gardening
- Cleaning inside windows

Wherever possible the same support worker will visit each time to provide continuity.

This service is competitively priced and anyone over the age of 60 may be eligible. If you come to us for Help at Home, you'll also have access to all of our other services.

Home from Hospital

In south Shropshire we can offer free short term help and support for older people leaving hospital, after an illness or in a crisis.
