

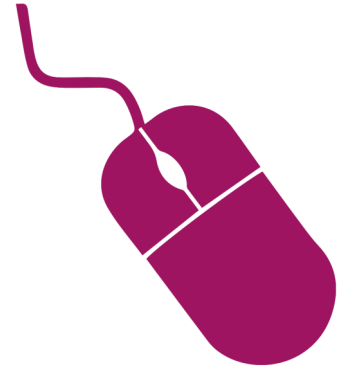
Ways to donate
