

100 Club Rules

Purpose

The purpose of the 100 Club is to raise funds. Money raised from the 100 Club will be paid into the Age UK Shropshire Telford & Wrekin bank account and used to help the charity to provide services which improve the quality of life for older people in the county.

Rules

1. For a cost of £2 per month (i.e. per draw) you will be allocated one number between 1 and 100.
2. A draw will be made every month with a 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize.
3. The prizes will total 45% of the monthly income.
4. This will be apportioned as: 1st prize of 25%, 2nd prize of 15% and 3rd prize of 5% (of total monthly income).
5. The 100 Club is a small society lottery and is open to all clients, supporters, volunteers and staff of Age UK Shropshire Telford & Wrekin. Anyone age 16 or over can join.
6. Numbers are limited to two per household.
7. Payments must be made by standing order (preferably annually) or annual cheque. One month's notice is required for cancellation.
8. Member's numbers will only be entered if their subscription is up to date.
9. If a member has no valid reason for missing a payment, their number may be sold to someone on the reserve list.
10. The draw shall be made by a member of public on the 27th day of each month.
11. The winning cheque will be posted to the address on your membership application within one week of the draw.
12. The name and numbers for each month's winners will be posted on the charity's website and social media accounts (unless the winners wish to remain anonymous).
13. The 100 Club will be run by Age UK Shropshire Telford & Wrekin. In case of any dispute the decision of the Chief Executive is final.
14. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the 100 Club if his/her subscription renewal remains unpaid for a period of one month.
15. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into Age UK Shropshire Telford & Wrekin funds after six months.
