



100 Club Rules

Purpose

The purpose of the 100 Club is to raise funds. Money raised from the 100 Club will be paid into the Age UK Solihull bank account and used to help the Charity to provide services which improve the quality of life for older people in the borough.

Rules

- 1. For a cost of £2 per month (i.e. per draw) you will be allocated one number between 1 and 100.
- 2. A draw will be made every month with a 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize. The first draw will take place on Thursday 24 November 2016.
- 3. The prizes will total 45% of the monthly income.
- 4. This will be apportioned as: 1st prize of 25%, 2nd prize of 15% and 3rd prize of 5% (of total monthly income).
- 5. The 100 Club is a small society lottery (registered with Solihull Metropolitan Borough Council under licence number 079663) and is open to all clients, supporters, volunteers and staff of Age UK Solihull. Anyone age 16 or over can join.
- 6. Numbers are limited to two per household.
- 7. Payments must be made by standing order (annually) or annual cheque. Once your annual subscription has been made, it cannot be cancelled part way through the year and no refunds will be offered. One month's notice is required for cancellation of your annual subscription.
- 8. Member's numbers will only be entered if their subscription is up to date.
- If a member misses a payment, we will assume you have cancelled your membership and we may sell your number to someone on the reserve list.
- 10. The draw shall be made by a member of public on the last Thursday of the month (with the exception of December when we will draw it on the Thursday before Christmas Day). The first draw will take place on Thursday 24 November 2016.
- 11.If you win, the winning cheque will be posted to the address on your membership application, normally within one week of the draw. It is your responsibility to let us know if your address changes and we cannot be held responsible for any cheques that go astray, where a change of address has not been notified to us.

- 12. The surname and numbers for each month's winners will be posted on the Charity's website and social media accounts (unless the winners wish to remain anonymous as indicated on the original Membership Form).
- 13. The 100 Club will be run by Age UK Solihull. In case of any dispute the decision of the Chief Executive Officer is final.
- 14. A member will be deemed to have left the 100 Club if his/her subscription renewal remains unpaid for a period of one month.
- 15. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into Age UK Solihull funds after three months.
