Solihull has an older than average population, with **over 65s representing 21.1% of the population**, compared with the national average of 18.6%. Our services are therefore always in great demand.



For many older people, particularly those living alone, there is **no-one to turn to** when there is a problem in their life. We are here to help to ensure that the support they need is available and that their **voice is heard**.

The cost-of-living crisis has made things **even more difficult** for older people, many of whom are living on a modest pension and are finding themselves unable to buy the food they need or pay their bills.

We are here

Age UK Solihull is an **independent, local charity** that has been supporting older people in Solihull for **over 40 years**.

Our services offer **information, advice, companionship** and **practical support** to older Solihull residents who need us more than ever.

Our phone lines have been inundated with calls from Solihull residents who are struggling with **loneliness, isolation** and the **rising cost of living**, amongst other challenges that come with later life. The number of people accessing our **Older People's Information & Advice** service has increased by **more than 2.5 times** in the last two years, and our **Linking People Together** project has a long waiting list for our **befriending** service and our **social clubs**, both of which are so vital for lonely older people.
