Free first time gas central heating

Check to see if you could be eligible



We will be providing support for up to 125 owner-occupied households using external funding from National Grid.

Switching to gas central heating provides residents with many benefits. These include:

- Improving energy efficiency
- Reducing the running cost for residents
- Improving the health of local people which could be made worse by living in a cold home



You may be eligible for this scheme if you:

- Own your home and have lived there for three years or more
- Have old electric storage heating
- In receipt of any income related benefit or have a household income below £32,062

Eligibility

Solihull's Warm Homes Fund can provide grant funding to eligible households.

Solihull Council are working with Dodd Group and Act On Energy to provide free gas central heating to some Solihull residents. The scheme will focus on the central heating to homes where gas is not the primary heating source. If electricity is used for your heating you may be eligible to have this replaced with a gas condensing boiler.
