#### **GoodGym launches in Stockport**



On Tuesday 28th August, GoodGym will be launching in Stockport supported by AUKS and Stockport Borough Council. They are a group of runners that combine regular exercise with helping their local community by: doing

physical tasks for community organisations, helping older people with one off tasks they can no longer do alone, such as clearing gardens or changing lightbulbs or making social visits to isolated older people.

For their first run, they will be running from Life Leisure at Grand Central to the Heatons Centre to help Signpost for Carers manage their green space with some painting and cutting back, so that all their visitors will be able to enjoy a breath of fresh air in a relaxing space.

The Silver Line is the only confidential, free helpline for older people across the UK open every day and night of the year. Their specially-trained helpline team:

- Offer information, friendship and advice.
- Link callers to local groups and services.
- Offer regular friendship calls.

Protect and support older people who are suffering abuse and neglect.

68% of calls to the helpline are made at night and weekends.

## DON'T LET FRAUDSTERS Don't Be Scammed!

Greater Manchester Police are warning that fraudsters have been contacting people by phone pretending to be police officers and trick them out of their money.

- Never give money or personal information to someone you do not know or trust.
- Never disclose your bank details or PIN number.

• A police officer will never ask you for bank details or to withdraw or transfer money to another account.

- Fraudsters will pressure you into making unwise decisions. They might tell you not to speak about it to other people so they don't get caught.
- Be suspicious of phone calls, texts or emails which come out of the blue asking for personal and financial details or asking you to withdraw money regardless of who they claim to be.

• If you receive a call that raises your suspicions hang up the phone and allow at least five minutes for the line to clear. If you spot a scam or have been scammed, report it and get help. Contact Action Fraud on 0300 123 2040 or online at www.actionfraud.police.uk
