Steady Bones

The 3rd 'Steady Bones' Education session for Osteoporosis was held in Heaviley, Stockport. This information event provides an invited group access to professional speakers to raise awareness of bone health and related services.

A Consultant Rheumatologist and lead specialist Pharmacist were on hand to advise about current research and treatments and provided a questions and answers session. Other speakers included therapists, a dietician, Life Leisure and the National Osteoporosis Society.
