The Age UK Suffolk Advocacy Service works as part of Total Voice Suffolk.

Advocacy is speaking and taking action with someone to ensure they can have their wishes heard, make their own choices and take control over their lives. This service is available to anyone over 55 years of age and living in Suffolk. If you have advocacy support needs during periods of disability or ill health, or are having to make decisions about your life and/or your care, Age UK Suffolk can help you.

There are over 15,000 older people in Suffolk who say that they are always, or often lonely – that's 1 in 10 people aged 65 and over.

Age UK Suffolk offers a free befriending service which connects older people with volunteers on a regular basis for a friendly chat. The befriender can also act as a link to help the befriending client to access a wide range of information, advice and other services.

The aim of the service is to reduce social isolation and to help make life more fulfilling.

The Chilton Club

The Chilton Club, on the outskirts of Sudbury, offers a safe, stimulating and fun environment for those with memory problems.

The club provides a specialist day service for up to 12 older people living with dementia, and are open Monday – Friday, 52 weeks a year, with the exception of Bank Holidays.

Members can choose to participate in the daily leisure activities and events, doing as much or as little as they wish, meet others, make new friends and enjoy a freshly cooked meal in a friendly and welcoming atmosphere.

Forget-Me-Not Groups & Relax & Reminisce Sessions

Dementia can be difficult to come to terms with whether you are affected or have a family member or friend with dementia.

'It's good to have an environment to go to that is safe and with other people in the same situation, share experiences, good for the cared for person to be able to socialise.'

Having access to the right information at the right time is an important part of living well with dementia. Age UK Suffolk's dementia friendly Forget-Me-Not groups offer time out for carers, and for those with memory problems.

Relax & Reminisce sessions are a chance to chat and reminisce. These can be themed one-off events, or ongoing sessions to groups of older people. All groups are dementia friendly and can be offered to community groups as well as care settings.

Both groups provide an opportunity to meet others, share experiences and enjoy activities together. In some circumstances Relax & Reminisce sessions can offer a 1-1 service in people's own homes.

Information & Benefits Advice

If you need time to outline your situation or concerns and prefer to talk to an advisor face to face, an appointment can be made at a local Age UK Suffolk advice surgery, or in certain circumstances they may be able to visit you at home.



It can be daunting knowing where to turn for help.

Age UK Suffolk's countywide Information and Advice line is staffed by friendly and knowledgeable staff who can give you information and benefits advice. There is a wide range of information for people aged 60+ (and their friends and family carers) at their fingertips and if Age UK Suffolk can't help, they often know of someone who can.

If you are over minimum state pension age, Age UK Suffolk can also help you to check your benefit entitlements, and assist you with completing benefit application forms.
