- They convene a bi-monthly Council Meeting
- Consult and work with other Older People's organisations within the North East Region of the UK, in particular The North East Regional Forum on Ageing.
- Play an active role in the implementation of Age UK campaigns in line with guidance from Age UK Sunderland
