Our Mission Statement

Age UK Sunderland aims to promote the well - being of all older people throughout the City of Sunderland, improve their quality of life and help them maintain Independence

Role Outline: Meaningful Connections Volunteers will work with older people from the LGBT+ community to facilitate social network groups and/or support the LGBT+ telephone support service.

Main Duties:

- To raise awareness of and promote the services of the Meaningful Connections project.
- To work with group members and other volunteers to plan, develop and promote LGBT+ social network groups and activities.
- To be present before, during and after social network group session to:
 - o welcome participants and keep a register
 - o facilitate social network group activities
 - encourage participation
 - create/develop a friendly atmosphere in which people can support each other/develop skills/improve their health and wellbeing and have fun
 - to provide feedback on the sessions and encourage members to provide suggestions for future development.
- To support the LGBT+ telephone support service, answer and respond to calls.
- Record all contacts made with clients.
- Keep up to speed with LGBT+ events that are taking place both locally and nationally.

Specific Responsibilities:

- To be willing to undertake induction training and any further training as required
- To participate in gatherings for the support and benefit of volunteers

Person Specification:

- Display empathy with LGBT+ people
- Good communication and listening skills
- An understanding of the need for confidentiality
- Approachable, caring and have a sense of humour
- Non-judgemental, reliable and dependable
- An understanding of how to promote good health and wellbeing
- Good organisational Skills



When & Where:

• Sessions take place at the Bradbury Centre on a weekly basis, Monday & Thursday's. It is possible that some sessions might take place in other venues within the City of Sunderland.

Hours of Work:

• Usually up to 3 hours per week.

Responsible to:

• Meaningful Connections Co-ordinator.

Expenses:

• Age UK Sunderland will repay any agreed expenses (e.g. travelling) on production of receipts/bus tickets/mileage report. Forms to be completed monthly.
