

VOLUNTEER ROLE: Check in and Chat Volunteer As people get older, some may find they spend more time on their own. This can sometimes feel lonely, boring and lacking in social interaction. As a Check in and Chat – Telephone Befriending - volunteer you can make a difference to the wellbeing of an older person's life. Our volunteer Check in and Chat Telephone Befriending service is for older people so they can enjoy chatting with someone over the phone, all from the comfort of their home with a weekly 30-minute chat (conversation length can vary) at a time which suits both volunteer and older person. You will be matched with a person who has similar interests to you. Hours: 30 minutes minimum a week at your convenience at an agreed time with your elderly telephone friend Supported by: Befriending / Wellbeing Team Location: Surrey Main Duties: Making time for a 30-minute call at a mutually agreed day and time each week. Being kind and respectful to your telephone friend. A commitment to volunteering with us for a minimum of 6-12 months is ideal Agreeing to our volunteer terms and conditions.
