To respond to where the need is greatest during this period of Stay home, Stay safe, we have set up two new services: Emergency Shopping and a Check in and Chat Call. We have been able to deliver these services by re-deploying staff to co-ordinate, and recruiting amazing volunteers who have stepped forward to help.

Emergency Shopping Service



This is a free service and available to older people who are not able to access online food deliveries or go to the shops because they are staying home to keep safe. The Emergency Shopping service is for people who need essential items. We can also help with collecting prescriptions.
