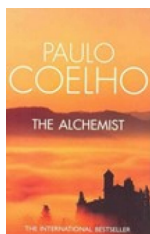


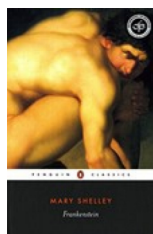
Book Club

We usually meet on the 2nd Thursday of the month at 2pm – 4pm.



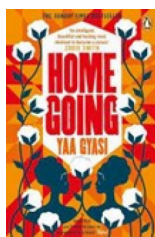

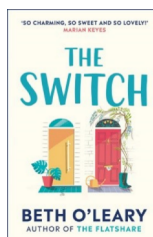
