Who is eligible?

- You must be referred for this service by Hospital Discharge Team
- You need to be 50 or over
- You need to live in either: Carlisle, Eden, Copeland or Allerdale areas

Who will deliver this service?

This is a funded service, delivered by Age UK West Cumbria, Age UK Carlisle & Eden.

All 'Well@Home' team members are fully trained to provide the best service possible.

Following your discharge from hospital

- You will receive regular welfare visits and phone check ups which will provide a short-term person-centred support after your discharge, plus further home visits for support and access to community services.
- The Well@Home team will perform a well-being review and give advice on where to find further support if needed.

The Services your WellaHome Team can offer:

- Cleaning in advance of your discharge
- Keysafe installation
- Setting up digital services, such as online shopping
- Telecare support
- Move@Home exercises to help you build strength
- Setting up services to support you after the Well@Home support has finished
- Signposting to other relevant Age UK and/or other Third Sector services








Our Service

The nail cutting service is specifically for people aged 50 and over, who cannot cut their own nalls. We provide an efficient, professional nail cutting service which is value for money.





We CAN treat clients who:


