<b>Location:</b>	A venue in Burgess Hill
<b>Hours:</b>	Ideally 3-4 hours per month

#### **About Age UK West Sussex, Brighton & Hove (AUKWSBH):**

AUKWSBH is a local charity working in our community to help older people. Over the years we've grown in order to provide vital services to those in need, firstly as Age Concern, then in 2010 changing our name to Age UK. Initially we were three separate organisations: Age UK West Sussex, Age UK Brighton & Hove and Age UK Horsham District. We merged in 2020 to become AUKWSBH.

#### **About the role:**

As a Men's Group Leader, you will be facilitating a small group of men in a small friendly pub to meet up in a laid-back informal environment. The group can be shaped to the needs of the client group and can be run as is convenient to the leader which would run monthly, for up to 2 hours. Clients can buy their own drinks as needed from the bar.

#### **Main tasks:**

- Ensure the relevant information on group and clients is recorded and sent to the appropriate person

#### **Role requirements:**

We are looking for people who are:

- Ideally a male to facilitate this specific type of group
- Understanding of the needs of older people
- Understanding of the need to observe confidentiality in informal settings
- Kind, empathic and patient
- Fun and have a friendly character
- Keen on meeting people and supporting them to love later life

**How we will support you:**

You will get ongoing support. You will also be invited to attend volunteer support sessions, where you will always be encouraged to share your thoughts and concerns.

**Induction and training:**

You will get a full induction and there will be training. This will help you do the role well and confidently.
