

**Thank you for considering leaving a gift in your will.

When making or amending your will, we recommend that you speak to a qualified professional such as a solicitor.

You can choose to leave a residuary gift (a share of your estate after taxes and debts have been paid), a pecuniary gift (a fixed sum of money) or a specific gift (a specific possession such as a painting).

Your solicitor can advise you on the required wording to carry out your wishes. If you would like to leave a kind gift to Age UK Westminster, please see suggested wording below.

Residuary Gift

Pecuniary / Specific Bequest

I further direct that the receipt of the Chief Executive or other proper officer of the said charity for the time being shall be a full and sufficient discharge for the said gift.
