

Volunteering



Age UK Westminster offers a variety of volunteering opportunities so we can provide roles suitable for everybody

Befriending Volunteer- Befriend an isolated and lonely older person living in your neighbourhood

Age UK Westminster are passionate about tackling loneliness and isolation among older people in our community, we are calling on local people across Westminster to join our Befriending scheme and form lasting friendships with older people living in the neighbourhood. 1 to 2 hours per week of your time will make a massive difference to someone's life. A volunteer would telephone or visit once a week for a friendly chat over a cup of tea, accompany them on a short walk or enjoy a trip out to the cinema or theatre together.

Community Outreach Volunteers- Inform local people about Age UK Westminster's services

Help us to inform local residents about our free services, activities and support that we offer. Help signpost people to us by distributing our leaflets and information to various local community organisations, such as GP Surgeries, Libraries, Day Centres, Churches, Community Centres or Sheltered Accommodation Schemes across Westminster.

Events Volunteer- Come and support Age UK Westminster at events as and when you can

We are recruiting a large pool of dedicated volunteers to help out with our fundraising activities and coomunity events. The role will involve help with setting up information stands at events, representing us and promoting our organisations work. This role would suit someone who wants to volunteer without the need to commit on a regular basis, but instead us as and when they are available.

Reception and Admin Support

Help out in our office supporting our team with administrative duties, answering telephone calls, giving information and signposting. This role would require someone who was available one day a week for 4 hours between the hoyrs of 10 - 2pm.

Help out in our local shop as a Retail Customer Service Volunteer. The role would involve cash handling, serving customers and operation a till, sorting and preparing donations, organising displays.

Community Activity Volunteer

Help run group activity sessions which benefit older residents in the community such as coffee mornings, arts & craft classes, IT sessions etc or organise and hold a fundraising activity raising funds on our behalf.

IT Support

Provide basic IT training and technical support, help design leaflets and fliers and data input.
