Celebrating our 30th Anniversary!

We recently marked our 30th anniversary with a fantastic community celebration, joined by local residents, partners, and special guests including the Mayor of Wigan Borough.

The event featured inspiring talks, performances, and a special video message from Martin Lewis, the Money Saving Expert, recognising our work in helping older people access the money they are entitled to like pension credit.

Since 1995, we estimated we have supported over 150,000 people across the borough—tackling loneliness, providing essential services, and helping people stay independent in their own homes. Thank you to everyone who has been part of our journey so far!

Our Services







Support at Home

Our paid-for Home Help and Handyperson services are designed to support everyday tasks, helping people live safely and independently in their own homes.

Between April 2024 and April 2025, our Handyperson team completed an impressive 3,655 jobs in people's homes! A big part of our work is fitting minor adaptations—small but impactful changes that make a big difference. These include fitting grab rails, bannisters, and other safety features that blend seamlessly into the home. We've recently introduced more discreet and stylish options, like the elegant plant pot holder rail shown in the photo. These adaptations offer not only safety and comfort but also a touch of personal style, helping people feel proud of their living space while staying secure.

This year also marked a special moment for our team—Ray, a beloved member of our Handyperson service, retired after nearly fourteen years. We celebrated his incredible contribution with a heartfelt send-off. We're thrilled that Ray will continue to support us as a volunteer.

From April 2024 to April 2025, our Home Help team delivered over 20,216 hours of support to local residents. The service continues to receive glowing feedback.

We're proud of the difference these services make every day.



Information & Advice

Our free Information and Advice service is here to help with a wide range of topics, such as tackling poverty by helping people understand benefits like Pension Credit and Attendance Allowance to practical support such as completing applications.

In total, last year we supported clients to secure £2.18 million in additional income.

Steps to Success

Our free Steps to Success programme engages individuals aged 50 and over in local activities and hobbies, providing opportunities to forge new friendships and strengthen community ties. Our team works closely with individuals, helping them over a six-week journey to help them feel more positive, confident, and active as well as reducing social isolation and loneliness. Our service improves the experience of getting older and supports the way people age across the Wigan Borough.



Event

We celebrated the one-year anniversary of our Steps to Success service, delivered in partnership with Groundwork CLM. The event brought together local professionals for an afternoon of networking, presentations, and interactive activities.

A highlight was a powerful video produced by Yellow Jigsaw where our fantastic volunteer Kath F became a reporter and interviewed one of our Steps to Success clients to showcase the real-life impact of the service.
