Our Wellbeing Checks with Meals service offers older people the reassurance of a friendly visit at home each lunchtime, with the added bonus of a delicious, nutritious meal (and pudding!).

Every day of the year (except Christmas Day), our caring, trained members of staff stop by to check on clients' wellbeing, offering peace of mind to older people and their families. Alongside this, we bring a hot, freshly prepared meal, designed by dietitians and nutritionists to support good health and more importantly, taste great!

With over 100 menu choices and options for special diets - from gluten-free to low sugar - there's something for everyone. Our team can also help plate the meal if needed, offering further reassurance for our customers.

Families often tell us how much the visits mean to them. One relative said: "More than the meals, it's the checking on Dad and letting me know whenever you felt something might be amiss - I can't tell you how much I've appreciated your input in his life."

They have recently begun a new project, supported by the artist Sue Martin, which will run up to Christmas and is sure to result in some incredible pieces of art.




Community Support Services coming soon to new areas in Wiltshire



After the success of the Melksham Community Support service, initiated and supported by Melksham Without Parish Council and Melksham Town Council (please see our next issue for news of an exciting award!) we secured one year funding from Wiltshire Council to run a similar service in Bradford on Avon and Trowbridge.

We are now excited to announce the arrival of two new Community Support services, one covering the Calne and Marlborough areas and the other the South West of the county (see the below picture for the areas covered).

Both have been funded by Wiltshire Council for one year. These Community Support projects offer face-to-face support, access to information and practical help to older people who are feeling isolated or vulnerable.

Surviving Winter Grant – What is it, and how do I apply?

The Surviving Winter Grant was introduced by Wiltshire and Swindon Community Foundation 10 years ago and has helped thousands of vulnerable households in Wiltshire living in fuel poverty. We are delighted to be working with Wiltshire and Swindon Community Foundation to help older people afford heating this winter.



Age UK Wiltshire may be able to offer you a one-off grant of £200 through this scheme! We open for applications in September 2025 and the scheme will close around March 2026 (or sooner if all grants are allocated). You could be eligible for this grant (1 per household) if you meet the below criteria:

- Are aged over State Pension age, and:
 - Receive a means-tested benefit or have a household income below £361pw (single person household) / £546 per week (couples or larger households). We also consider savings you have.
 - Live in fuel poverty (we consider your heating needs, usage and difficulties in maintaining a warm home)

Grants are considered on a case by case basis. This grant can be awarded in addition to the government's 'Winter Fuel Payment' (£100 - £300) and your electricity supplier's 'Warm Home Discount' (£140) which you may also qualify for.

Call us on 0808 196 2424 to apply or use the contact form on our website and we can send you an application pack in the post. As part of the application process we will complete a free income maximisation check to ensure you are receiving everything you are entitled to.

We'll also have a conversation with you about how you manage your heating and energy usage to look at the reasons for your high fuel bills and whether you could be eligible for other support.

Our next trip after that is to get some Christmas shopping done at the vibrant Christmas Market in Winchester!




