Working directly with older people, often visiting people at home, you'll have a direct impact on their quality of later life, helping to put money into people's pockets and supporting them to become better connected with their communities.

The post is seven hours a week, working pattern to be agreed, and covers the areas of Laverstock, Ford, and the communities of Bishopdown Farm (Hampton Park and Riverdown Park), Old Sarum, Longhedge and part of Milford. Travel expenses will be paid from the base area.

If you have empathy, a natural affinity with people and an understanding of the issues affecting older people in your community, we'd love to hear from you!
