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COVID19 Procedures

When a member of the team visits your home to deliver a meal, they will:

- Use an alcohol gel/spray on their hands before leaving our vehicle and removing your meal from the thermal container
- If they deliver your meal to you without entering your home, they will maintain a safe distance from you whilst delivering the meal
- If they enter your home, they will maintain a safe distance from you at all times within your home
- If you would prefer they wore either a facemask or other PPE in your home, they will happily do so
- Our staff may choose to wear facemasks or PPE for their own safety, even if you have not requested this
- When they leave your home, they will take away any used PPE and dispose of this within our vehicle
- Prior to leaving your address, they will again use the alcohol gel/spray on their hands



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
