Wiltshire and Swindon, every day of the year except Christmas Day.

But it's much more than a meal delivery. Each visit includes a friendly wellbeing check from a trained team member who becomes a familiar face. They not only make sure the meal is plated and ready to eat, they also take a moment to see how the person is doing, chat with them and check all is well. For many, this visit is a reassuring part of their day and an important point of contact.

Employed by Community First as part of the Carers Together Wiltshire Partnership, the Carer Coordinator plays a pivotal role in providing support, guidance, and resources to Carers. They are responsible for carrying out statutory Carers Assessments on behalf of Wiltshire Council.

They work to ensure that unpaid Carers have access to necessary support services, information, and opportunities for respite, enabling them to fulfil their unpaid caring responsibilities effectively while maintaining their own well-being.
