One-off grants for individuals

Age UK Wiltshire can help eligible clients apply for grants in the region of up to £300 to help with household essentials, unexpected bills, heating costs. You must be on a low income and be able to demonstrate that you could not afford the expense. These cannot be paid retrospectively. Turn2Us (www.turn2us.org.uk) has a database of grants.

Warm Home Discount

If you meet 'broader group' criteria set by your electricity provider, or if you receive Guaranteed Pension Credit, then you could get £140 credit to help with your fuel bills. Contact your electricity supplier to ask if you qualify, from around Aug-Sept.

Help with health costs—NHS low income scheme

If they have less than £16000 and are on a low income, or if you receive certain means-tested benefits, then you could qualify for help with NHS health costs such as glasses, dentists and hospital travel costs. Tel: 0300 330 1343.

Free help and advice to remain independent

Free needs assessment from Wiltshire Council

This usually involves an occupational therapist visiting you at home to discuss your needs. As a result of the assessment, the local authority can provide:

- a report of what the needs are (this can help you make decisions about care and support)
- up to £1000 of free aids and minor adaptations, regardless of finances. This could include items like grab rails, ramps and bath seats. A 'Disabled Facilities Grant' may be available for larger adaptations.
- Means-tested funding towards a care package (usually an individual must have less than £23,250 in capital)

Support for carers

Request a free carer's assessment from Wiltshire Council (same details as above) if your caring role is having a significant impact on your wellbeing. As a result of the assessment you could receive: help with your caring role, respite care, aids, support to complete a carer's emergency card. The local authority can help fund some of this.

Saving you money

Income maximisation check

Age UK Wiltshire offer free checks to ensure you are maximising your entitlement to benefits; we can even help you to apply. If you have health problems or are a carer there may be extra money available which is not means-tested.

Priority Service Registers

Free to join and offer a range of free services and support, including help during a power cut. Tel: **0800 294 3259** (Scottish & Southern power distributors in Wiltshire). Also contact your domestic energy company to register for theirs.

Wessex Water discount

If you receive Pension Credit, or everyone in your household receives only State Pension, then you can apply for a discount on your water bill. You could also consider a water meter if you are a low user. Tel: **0345 600 3600**

Council Tax Discount (non means-tested)

You could qualify for a discount from Wiltshire Council if you are a carer (who is caring for someone other than your spouse); or if you have made significant adaptations to your home due to disability; or if someone in the household has a cognitive or memory impairment. Tel: **0300 456 0109**
