
Living Well - Based in GP surgeries, this service supports people to live a healthy and fulfilling life and to live independently at home.

AMAZING OUTCOMES FOR THE LIVING WELL TEAM

The Living Well service, based within GP surgeries in the north of Wiltshire, reduces the amount of contact patients have with the surgery for non-medical concerns.



One surgery we work with reviewed the number of consultations a patient received in the eight months prior to their Living Well referral, compared to the eight months after first contact, and found that the number of surgery consultations reduced by 314% following our involvement and support.

ARTS & FRIENDSHIP CLUBS COMING SOON!



We are delighted to announce that from September, we will be running the fortnightly arts clubs in Pewsey, Marlborough and Devizes, following the handover from Arts Together.

We're honoured to continue the legacy of their incredible work and are so grateful for the opportunity to bring creativity and companionship to older people in these communities who may be feeling isolated or lonely. WINTER FUEL PAYMENT

The Government have recently announced that:

- Everyone over the State Pension age in England and Wales with an income of, or below, £35,000 a year will benefit from a Winter Fuel Payment this winter.
- This increased threshold means no lower or middle-income pensioners will miss out, with over three quarters of pensioners in England and Wales receiving the payment – a total of 9 million people.
- The Payment will be paid automatically to everyone over State Pension Age and clawed back automatically through PAYE or income tax for those whose income exceeds £35,000. Find out more.

Please note that no one will text you about Winter Fuel payments. If you get a text about a "Winter Fuel Payment" it is a scam. Winter Fuel Payments are made automatically, you do not need to do anything.
