- All volunteers will wear a Door Knock ID badge
- Volunteers will not ask to come into your home.
- Volunteers may ask to write down some information so we are able to offer you more support in the future – they will ask you to sign the form giving your permission to pass on your details to the relevant partner.
- Volunteers will not ask for donations.
