NATIONAL MEMORIAL ARBORETUM

The Aboretum was officially opened, to the public, in May 2001 by Her Royal Highness the Duchess of Kent, with the Armed Forces Memorial, a national monument to those who lost their lives on duty or as an act of terrorism since the Second World War, being dedicated six years later in 2007. Full of symbolism, the memorials and gardens are there to tell the stories of those remembered.

On visiting, you will be fascinated by the wide range of memorials on site: some military, some for specific campaigns, some for emergency services, along with tributes for civilians.
