Role Description

Role purpose

The purpose of the dementia café volunteer is to help provide support to people who have received a diagnosis of dementia.

Main tasks/activities

Tasks include, but not limited to:

- Prepare and serve refreshments for attendees.
- Clear tables and assist with washing up.
- Help set up the venue before the cafe starts and pack away at the end.
- Welcome, engage and spend time with people living with dementia and their carers.
- Offer general support to attendees.
- Work as part of a team.

Skills/experience

We are looking for individuals who have:

- An interest in and understanding of issues facing people living with dementia.
- Are committed to inclusion and treating people from all backgrounds with dignity
- Good communication skills.
- Recognise the importance of confidentiality.
- Patient and reliable.
- Are prepared to complete any necessary initial and ongoing learning.

Days/hours

Our dementia cafés run monthly in different locations. Each café runs for 2 hours, plus set up/pack away time.
