Role Description

Role purpose

Waiting lists for foot care are very lengthy across Herefordshire & South Worcestershire. We aim to make it easier for our clients to receive the foot care they need with reduced waiting times and costs.

Main tasks/activities

As a Foot Care assistant, you will help us provide basic foot care for our clients and assist with the running of the clinics.

Tasks include, but not limited to:

- Assist with basic foot care (including nail clipping and filing)
- Greet clients and welcoming them to the clinic
- Liaise with our Foot Care Coordinator and Foot Health Practitioners

Skills/experience

Ideally, you will have some previous experience in health care/foot care, or you are studying towards this. We are also looking for individuals who have:

- Good communication skills
- Empathy and patience
- A caring and polite attitude
- The ability to work as an individual

Days/hours

Starting from approximately 2 hours per week, depending on volunteer availability

Background checks

As part of joining our Footcare team, we'll ask you to complete an Enhanced DBS (Disclosure and Barring Service) check and provide two references, to ensure everyone we support stays safe and well cared for.

Expenses

We reimburse reasonable expenses incurred, for example travel costs.
