- Supporting the engagement and interaction of attendees during sessions
- Setting up and preparing the environment.
- Preparing and serving refreshments whilst maintaining a clean and tidy environment.
- Supporting assessments and administration
- Working as part of a team

- Good communication skills.
- Recognise the importance of confidentiality.
