Role purpose

Main tasks/activities

Tasks include, but not limited to:

- Transportation of Goods: Safely transport goods and supplies between our retail shops and other locations as needed. This includes loading and unloading items, ensuring they are securely stowed during transit
- Customer Service: Provide friendly and courteous service to all customers and staff, acting as a representative of our Charity and maintaining a positive image
- Compliance: Adhere to all organisational policies, including, lone working, health and safety regulations

- An ability to work independently and as a team
