Role purpose

The purpose of the dementia outing volunteer is to help provide support to people who have received a diagnosis of dementia under the age of 65 (max acceptance age is 70).

Main tasks/activities

Tasks include, but not limited to:

- Supporting the delivery of outings
- Welcoming and supporting attendees
- Engagement and interaction with attendees
- Supporting safety and coordination
- Signposting and additional support
- Working as part of a team

- An interest in and understanding of issues facing people living with dementia.
- Are committed to inclusion and treating people from all backgrounds with dignity
- Good communication skills.
- Recognise the importance of confidentiality.
- Patient and reliable.
- Are prepared to complete any necessary initial and ongoing learning.

As part of joining our Dementia team, we'll ask you to complete an Enhanced DBS (Disclosure and Barring Service) check and provide two references, to ensure everyone we support stays safe and well cared for.
