We have continued helping owners, who are most at risk and have the greatest needs, to walk their dogs throughout lockdown. We have also continued to foster dogs that were already in our care and any new ones that needed help. Owners have been contacted regularly by telephone to have a chat and a catch up.

This has been an extremely busy time for Keep Your Pet and the support from our volunteers has been amazing. All that has been sustained without any regular fundraising activities and will continue as long as we have willing and available volunteers.

More wonderful volunteers arrived to set up the cafe with delicious sandwiches and home-made cakes.

The day proceeded with a steady flow of customers, despite showers and the continuing wariness of a lot of people to be in an enclosed space. We took £716. After hall hiring expenses etc. the final figure was £615.83.
