# **Out and About**

Helping older people to maintain their independence and make social connections



### What do we do?

The Out and About service is intended to help older people maintain their independence and make social connections.

The aim is to support people on a short-term basis following difficulties, illness or other crisis that has affected their confidence and their ability to participate in activities they enjoy.

Input could be as simple as supporting a person in taking a walk, catching a bus, meeting friends, visiting shops or joining group activities in the local community.



### How does it work?

An Age UK York Support Worker will visit you to discuss your interests and aspirations.

Together, we will develop a plan to support you to achieve this. They will also consider any issues and concerns you may have.

Support will typically be for 2-3 hours a week over a 6-8 week period, although this may vary depending on your individual circumstances.

The service operates Monday to Friday.

## Who do we help?

The service is aimed at people who have suffered a setback resulting in loneliness and / or a loss of confidence.

This might include people who have experienced illness or injury, been hospitalised, bereaved, or isolated due to the COVID pandemic or other circumstances.
