How does it work?





I need to know: Will I have training? You'll have training to prepare you for the role

- Dementia awareness and communication skills training
- Safeguarding training covers key aspects of volunteering in a care home including your own health, safety, conduct and welfare

Are there set hours?

 You can spend as much or little time as available, however, a regular pattern benefits both you and the care home





Do I need a DBS?

Care homes generally require DBS, you'll be advised on the process

How will I be introduced to the care home?

- An induction at the care home to welcome and support you during your visit
- Your key contact at the care home will assist with any questions or concerns

Will I have any resources?

Age Cymru 'Tell Me More' conversation cards and game will be provided
