Our services include:

#### **Care services:**

- **Day care** supporting people to live independently and stay socially connected
- **Domiciliary care** helping those who wish to remain in their own home, supporting family carers
- Meadowbank residential care home - helping people to live well with dementia

#### Wellbeing support:

- **First Connect** one-to-one practical and emotional support for older people at times of transition, eg. bereavement or ill health, reducing isolation, improving wellbeing, keeping people connected.
- **Memory Link** providing information and support to people who require a memory assessment.

We inform and lobby local and Northern Ireland government to prepare and plan more effectively for the opportunities and challenges of our ageing society.

We work with Age NI's Consultative Forum whose role is to inform, advise and challenge Age NI and others on what matters to older people.

Our priorities are clear. We want to see:

- a health and social care system which delivers best quality care in later life
- a reduction in pensioner poverty
- the rights of older people strengthened to end unfair and discriminatory treatment when accessing goods, facilities and service







#### We Innovate



We continue to work in partnership to influence and change how services are delivered for older people. Recent partnerships include:

- **Good Vibrations:** Age NI has teamed with the Movember Foundation to create Good Vibrations, a new programme designed to provide information, tips, advice, and support to help men over 50 navigate the ups and downs of later life.
- **Check-in and Chat:** Supported by the Commissioner for Older People, this service provides weekly friendship calls to people who are lonely or isolated.
- **Bespoke Services:** we have a range of bespoke services developed in conjunction with Health & Social Care Trusts, such as Living Well Moyle, Community Navigators, and Staying Sharp, which aim to build greater resilience and help older people stay connected to their communities.
