

Race information

Race Start

The Dash will start on The Headrow at **09:30**. Baggage collection, toilets and the warm up can be found in Millennium Square. This area is for competitors only prior to the race.

Please note, you do not need to register on the day of the event.

Wheelchair Race

The wheelchair race starts at **08:55**.

Junior Race

This will begin at **09:10**, please see *page 6* for more information.

Running Number

You cannot swap your race number or let someone race on your behalf. On race day please pin your number to the FRONT of your running top. Do not cut, fold or damage in any way as this will lead to disqualification.

The colour of your race number will correspond with your pre-race start pen. Please make sure you start in the matching pen.

Timing Chip

The timing chip is already attached to your running number. The chip will activate as soon as you cross the start line. Your time will be recorded as you pass the finish line.

Hydration Stations

Water is at the 5km turn point. Our hydration partner iPro Sport will provide drinks at the finish line.

Baggage

Your baggage tag is attached to your race number. Please attach the tag to your bag before handing it over.

Transport

Roads around the start line will be closed. The Elland Road Park and Ride has extended opening hours, from 07:30 and the first bus will depart at 07:40. For car parking we recommend using the Merrion Centre or Rose Bowl Car Park (fees apply).

Leeds Train Station will be closed Saturday 26th October 23:40 to Sunday 27th October 11:40. After this time there will be a limited service until 04:00 on Monday 28th October.

Race Finish

Your time will only be recorded by crossing the finish line. Once you have crossed the finish line please keep on moving to collect all of your post-race goodies.

Race Results

If you provided us with a UK mobile number you will receive a text confirming your time. The full list of results and category prize winners will be found at **www.ageuk.org.uk/dash** on the afternoon of the race.

First Aid

Medical assistance can be found at the start, along the route, and at the finish line. Please contact an event marshal for further assistance.



Safety

If you feel ill prior to race day please make sure you are able to participate safely. Seek medical advice if unsure.

In a medical emergency on race day we will refer to your contact details on the reverse of your race number, please make sure these are filled out.

We discourage you from wearing headphones on the course.

Do not leave bags unattended and please listen to all instructions.

Weather

In the event of bad weather please keep as warm and dry as possible.

General

We reserve the right to postpone or cancel the event owing to adverse weather conditions or circumstances beyond our control. Please check **www.ageuk.org.uk/dash** for the latest information.

On-site facilities

Information Tent

The main information tent is in Millennium Square with a second information tent outside the Town Hall. Please only visit the Millennium Square tent to collect a replacement race number. You do not need to register at the information tent.

Baggage

The baggage tents will be open from **07:30**. Please place your bag tag on your bag. This can be found at the bottom of your race number.

Baggage 1: is located at Victoria Gardens and is for all yellow, light blue, pink and purple race numbers.

Baggage 2: is located in Millennium Square for orange, green or dark blue race numbers.

Toilets

The majority of these can be found in Millennium Square. There will be a few at the finish area for spectators.

Catering

There will be catering vans outside the Town Hall

Changing Facilities

Unfortunately there are no changing facilities on site.

Lost children

Please report lost children to the Age UK information tent - map *page 8 & 9*.

Recovery

TRIB3 will be offering free massages in Millennium Square.

Top 2 Toe Therapy will provide EMETT muscle release at the race finish.





Start area

The race will start at **09:10**. The 10 minute warm up will begin at 09:00 at the start line on the Headrow; see page 8 & 9.

Route

Finish area

The finish line will be located on The Headrow, opposite the Town Hall. A parent or guardian must pick up their child from the junior repatriation area at the finish line from 09:20. You will require photo ID and the wristband located on the bottom of your child's race number.

Please remove the wristband from the race number before the race starts

Race number

The emergency contact details will be placed on the back of each number along with the timing chip device. Please attach the number to the front of your running top.

Prize giving

The top three male and female Junior Dashers are invited to a prize giving in front of the Town Hall at 09:45.

Baggage

There are no baggage or changing facilities for junior runners.



For health and safety reasons Junior Dasher's that arrive late will not be allowed to run.

Please arrive on time.





Anxiety and panic attacks led to Barbara becoming isolated and severely affecting her health and wellbeing.

"I struggled with talking to people, answering the door, going out – everything"
