

tomato

intermediate pattern

Yarn: Any DK weight yarn in red and green

Needles: 1 pair 3.75mm needles

Knitting:

Hat

Using red yarn and 3.75mm needles cast on 29 sts.

Row 1: (K6, P1) repeat to the end of the row K1

Row 2: P1 (K1, P6) to the end of the row.

Repeat rows 1 and 2 another six times

Next row: K2tog till last stitch K1 (15 st)

Next row: P2tog till last stitch P1 (8 st)

Cut the yarn leaving a long length. Thread this through the stitches and pull up to tighten.

Leaf tips

Make 3.

Make a slip knot

Row 1 (RS): Knit into the front, back and front again to make 2 additional sts. (3 sts)

Row 2 (WS): Purl.

Row 3: Kfb, k1, kfb. (5 sts)

Row 4: Purl.

Transfer the 5 sts onto a stitch holder or spare needle to hold them.



Abbreviations K = Knit P = Purl Tog = Together Sts = stitches St st = stocking stitch k2tog = knit two together P2tog = purl two together Kfb = knit into the front and then into the back to make a st WS = wrong side

Leaf top & stalk

Transfer the held sts for all 3 leaf tips onto one needle

Row 1 K2tog to last st, k1 (8 sts)

Row 2 P2tog 4 times (4 sts)

Now work an icord for 4 rows before breaking the yarn, threading it through the stitches and pulling it tight.

Sew up the tomato and sew on the leaves.

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
