

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 16A AS AMENDED BY THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION
(SPECIAL EVENTS) ACT 1994
LEEDS CITY COUNCIL
(ABBEY DASH ROAD RACE)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2018**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Leeds City Council, as traffic authority for the Leeds Metropolitan District, has today made an Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as inserted by Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation (Special Events) Act 1994, prohibiting and restricting the use of certain roads by vehicles to facilitate the holding of the Abbey Dash Road Race on Sunday 4 November 2018.

The event will require the closure of certain roads and road junctions in the Leeds City Centre as well as the suspension of a number of Traffic Regulation Orders.

The Order comes into effect on Saturday 3 November 2018 in respect of the parking restrictions and Sunday 4 November 2018 for the road closures and will continue in force as necessary during the course of the event between 05:00 hours and 14:00 hours. The roads to be closed are set out in the Schedule hereto. Where necessary, local diversions will be in operation, signed as appropriate.

The Order will not at any time prevent access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to any road to which the Order relates, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from, any such road.

A copy of the Order as made, a map of the route of the race and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order are available for inspection at Legal Services, Reception Desk, Civic Hall, Calverley Street Leeds 1 (Ref: A76/RAHardy/Development Team). SCHEDULE

ROAD CLOSURES:

NB - all roads either crossing or having a junction with the mentioned roads will be closed by default.

1. The Headrow (eastbound) - Oxford Place to Albion Street and (westbound) - Park Row to Oxford Place.
2. Inner Ring Road - Slip road from the eastbound carriageway to West Street & westbound carriageway to Park Lane.
3. East Parade – Junction with Infirmary Street and Junction with South Parade.
4. Westgate (westbound) - Oxford Place to Wellington Street.
5. Wellington Street (eastbound) – Kirkstall Road to Queen Street.
6. Wellington Street (westbound) – City Square to Kirkstall Road.
7. Queen Street (northbound) – Wellington Street to St Paul's Street
8. Park Row (northbound) – Infirmary Street to The Headrow
9. West Street – Kirkstall Road to Park Lane.
10. Willow Road - Kirkstall Road to Burley Road.
11. Kirkstall Road – West Street to commercial Road.
12. Commercial Road – Kirkstall Road to Abbey Road.
13. Bridge Road – Commercial Road to Savins Mill Way.
14. Abbey Road - Abbey Walk to Bridge Road.
15. Wellington Street – Junction with City Square.
16. Wellington Road (TGI off –slip) – Junction with Wellington Road.
17. Park Row (northbound) – Infirmary Street to The Headrow

SUSPENSIONS OF BUS ONLY LANES, RESTRICTED ACCESS, PARKING & ONE WAY FLOW

1. Westgate (Bus Only) - Eastbound between Park Street and Oxford Place.
2. Park Row (Bus Only) – Russell Street to Boar Lane and The Headrow to South Parade.
3. Vicar Lane (Bus Only) – Junction with Kirkgate.
4. Infirmary Street (Restricted Access) – King Street to City Square.
5. Abbey Road (Bus Only) – the whole Bus Lane.
6. Boar Lane (Bus Only) - the whole Bus Lane.
7. Cookridge Street (Suspension of parking from 5am Saturday 3rd November 2018) – The Headrow to St Anne's St.
8. Little Queens Street (Suspension of parking from 5am Saturday 3rd November 2018) – the whole.
9. St Pauls Street (Suspension of parking from 5am Saturday 3rd November 2018) – Little Queen Street to Queen St.
10. Duncan Street (Bus Only) – Eastbound between Duncan Street and New Market Street.
11. The Headrow (Restricted Access) - between Briggate and Albion Street.
